On 12/11/2012 at about 1600 hrs, I was called to assist Clackamas Count S.O. on an incident where Deceased, Jacob Roberts entered the Clackamas Town Center and shot several people.								
On the same date at about 1710 hrs, I arrived at the Town Center parking garage and was contacted by Mr. and Mrs. Zamudio. Mr. Zamudio was holding their small child. They told me that they were told by a police officer to go to the parking garage. I asked them if they were in the mall when the shooting started. They told me they were. They said that they were shopping at the M&H store when they hear a loud bang. They said that a few seconds later they heard a series of 8 or 9 bangs then glass shattering. They told me that the ran to the back of the M&H store and hid until police told them it was safe to leave. They told me that they did not see the shooter nor anyone that was shot.



<p>On 12/11/2012 at about 1600 hrs, I was called to assist Clackamas Count S.O. on an incident where Deceased, Jacob Roberts entered the Clackamas Town Center and shot several people.</p> <p>On the same date at about 1800 hrs, I was tasked with interviewing witnesses to the incident at the Town Center parking garage. I was contacted by Ms. Reid. Roxanne from Victims assistant was present during the interview. She said she was working at the Hollister store in the mall. She said he was in the back stock room that has a exit door to the mall area. She said that she heard a loud bang then a few seconds later she heard series of bangs. She estimated about 10 total. She said that she went to the front of the store and helped customers move to the back of the store, meanwhile her manager closed the main gate to the store. She said that a total of 18 people, consisting of customers and employes were in the back store room. She said all of them waited until an officer told them it was safe to leave. She was told by officers to come to the parking garage for an interview. Ms. Ried said she did not see the shooter nor anyone that was shot.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Referred.</p>



MENTIONED / NARRATIVE / CASE STATUS <p>On 12/12/2012, I was called to assist Clackamas Count S.O. on an incident where Deceased, Jacob Roberts entered the Clackamas Town Center and shot several people. I was asked to follow up on tips that were called in by citizens.</p> <p>On 12/13/2012 at about 1007hrs, I investigated tip #726-6 by contacting Brittany White. Mrs. White told me that on the day of the shooting she rode tri-met bus #79 from her work at 3pm to the town center mall. She said that a heavy set dark skinned male was sitting in front of her. She further described the male as having a pony tail and the rest of his hair being short or shaved. She said when the bus stopped at the mall at about 3:11pm, the male put on a snowboard type bandana. She described the bandana as being cloth with a black and white skull printed on it. She said that the male placed the bandana over the lower part of his face and exited the bus. She said that she also got off the bus at the mall. She said she watched the male enter the mall near the theater, while she waited for another bus to take her home. Mrs. White said several minutes later she heard gun shots coming from the mall. She said that an old lady came out of mall and offered to give her a ride home.</p> <p>CASE STATUS: Referred.</p>

<p>On 12/11/2012 at about 1600 hrs, I was called to assist Clackamas Count S.O. on an incident where Deceased, Jacob Roberts entered the Clackamas Town Center and shot several people.</p> <p>On the same date at about 1734 hrs, I was tasked with interviewing witnesses to the incident at the Town Center parking garage. I was contacted by Mr. Sieverking and his fiancé. Mr. Sieverking's fiancé was interviewed separately by a different investigator. Mr. Sieverking told me that he and his fiancé were at the mall eating in the upstairs food court. He said that he did not know what time it was, but remembered that they were most the way done with their meal when he heard a loud bang. He said that he thought it was a balloon popping, but a second later he heard a series of bangs. He told me that they were near the escalators and after the volley of shots he saw the down escalator's glass shatter. He said that he picked up his things and they followed a bunch of people out an exit. He said they were contacted by officers who told them to stay away. He said that they went to <i>McDonalds</i> then <i>Lover's</i> before returning to the mall to give their statement. He told me that he did not see the shooter nor did he see anyone that was shot.</p>

ACTION TAKEN

On 12/11/12 at approximately 1529 hrs Detective Sgt Tonkin, Detective Atkeson and I were in the Detective office at WLPD when we heard CCOM dispatch units to a shooting at the Clackamas Town Center, 12100 SE 82nd Ave.

I heard CCOM advise very soon after the initial dispatch that they have information this was now an active shooter incident and Sgt Tonkin, Detective Atkeson and I left the PD to assist.

On the way to the Town Center, I heard updates regarding the description of the shooter and his last known location (Possibly the Macy's Home Store) as well as locations where other officers were arriving. Since most officers sounded like they were arriving on the east side of the mall and the shooters last location was near the home store I went to the north side of the mall and parked near the movie theatre which is just west of the Macy's Home Store, at approximately 1535 hrs.

There, I met up with other officers who had arrived at the same time as me and we entered the mall through the north doors leading into the food court. We then made our way to the front of Macy's clothing store at the upper level entrance to listen for indicators while people were still evacuating the mall.

There, I noticed one victim deceased on the floor as well as several .223 caliber shell casings and at least one empty AR-15 style magazine on the floor in the aisle leading towards JC Penny's. The group I was in began clearing stores and corridors between Macy's and JC Penny's but after a few minutes we heard a group of officers to the west of us towards Sears verbally challenging someone and it didn't sound like they were complying so we changed our direction and headed that way to assist.

Along the way, I had to step around another deceased victim in front of the Best Buy Mobile store and through broken glass all over the floor between the store and the railing along the aisle.

At that time, the other situation had been dealt with and I assisted other officers in helping people evacuate the mall who were hidden in stores between the food court and Nordstroms. After several minutes I exited the mall after orders were given for all plain clothes officers to exit the mall.

After I stored my gear I went to the command post to help in interviewing witnesses.



NARRATIVE:

On December 11, 2012 around 3:30 PM I was in my office at the Brook's building when I heard Det. Nunn say there was an active shooter at the Clackamas Town Center Mall. Det. Nunn and I gathered our equipment and left towards the mall. As we were arriving we heard that the entrance/exits of the mall needed to be blocked to prevent people from coming into the mall. Det. Nunn parked her car across the entrance on the south side of the mall near JC Penney.



I then took flares and put them across one of the entrances from I205 south into the mall and I then stopped and directed traffic coming off the other onramp from I205 south into the mall to proceed through the parking lot and exit at the entrance where Det. Nunn's car was parked. I performed this task for approximately an hour before I was relieved by a Portland Police officer.

Det. Nunn and I then went to the Command Post and were instructed to check three buses that were stopped for any witnesses and interview any we found. We only found two witnesses on the buses. At about 5:00 PM I interviewed Melissa Pancurak and Det. Nunn interviewed her co worker (SEE SEPARATE INTERVIEW REPORTS).

I then responded to the Command Post where I was asked by Det. Kraus to compile a list from officers that had interviewed witnesses that provided a description of the suspect. I contacted several officers and wrote down the suspect information they provided me. I then transferred this list to a thumb drive and provided Det. Burlew with a copy (SEE ATTACHED). It appeared obvious from the list that there was only one suspect.

Also while at the Command Post I was asked by Sgt. Anderson to compile any information I could find on a Chris Darrens (question on spelling). I ended up locating on Christopher Dahrens, which I provided to Sgt. Anderson.

I was then asked to contact the family of Steven Forsyth and notify them of his death. I was told they were waiting at PSTC. I arrived at PSTC at about 7:30 PM. I contacted Sgt. Brisben who told me the family was waiting in a room (SEE NOTIFICATION REPORT).

At about 1:00 AM on December 12, 2012 I assisted detectives from Clackamas County execute a search warrant at Christopher Dahrens residence (SEE SEPARATE WARRANT REPORT). I left the Dahrens residence at about 2:00 AM.

NARRATIVE:

On December 11, 2012 around 5:00 PM I interviewed Melissa Pancurak in a Tri Met bus at the mall. I explained to Ms. Pancurak who I was and why I needed to talk to her. She told me she understood. Ms. Pancurak told me she is an employee of a kiosk named Sock It To Me. She told me the store is located on the upper level of the mall near the Seattle's Best Coffee, which is in the food court.

Ms. Pancurak told me she was standing at the kiosk with her employee and two customers. She said she was near the railing, which looks over the open area where you can see the first floor. She said she heard gun fire and looked up. She said she felt the impact of the sound of the shots as they were so loud. She said she thought she heard about seven shots. She said they were in bursts like bam bam bam, pause, bam bam bam, pause.

She said she told everyone to get down. She said she saw the shooter on the other side of the kiosk near Macy's shooting. Ms. Pancurak told me she was holding the customers heads down and trying to make sure they stayed there. She said the shooter walked away from Macy's to the east and was not very far from her kiosk when the shooter pointed the gun directly at her.


Ms. Pancurak said she was in the Marines and thought her training must have taken over because she turned herself on her side to try and make herself a narrower target to hit. She said for some reason the shooter didn't shoot and continued to walk east away from Macy's. She said once he was out of site they stayed where they were until an employee of a neighboring store told them to come into their store and they went in there and hid.

I asked her if she recalled about what time this all started. She said she was on the phone and had just gotten off it before this started so she thought it was about 3:30 when she heard the shots. She said she stayed with her employee and customers about five minutes until the other employee came and got them.

I asked Ms. Pancurak to describe the shooter to me. She said he was a thin man dressed all in black with a white mask. He was carrying a semi auto gun. She said the clothing seemed like a heavy weight material. She said he had a long sleeve top on with black pants. She thought he may have been just above average height based on the height of the store behind him. She said he was very thin and the mask looked like it was a hard surface. She told me the gun was a long gun.

NARRATIVE:

On December 12, 2012 at about 12:00 PM I was asked to contact two people in the lobby that wanted to provide information about the shooting. I went to the lobby and met Tommy and Jacob Illk. They told me they were friends of Mr. Roberts and would like to talk to me. I asked them if it would be okay if I spoke with them separately and they told me that was fine.

I first met with Tommy Illk privately in an interview room. I asked Tommy for identifying information, which he provided. I asked him how he knew Mr. Roberts. He told me they were friends and worked together at Big Bertha's. He told me he had known Mr. Roberts for about two years. He said he met Mr. Roberts through his brother Jacob. He told me Mr. Roberts and Jacob are childhood friends.

I asked Tommy what he knew about Mr. Roberts. He said he knew Mr. Roberts was adopted and doesn't have a lot of family. He said he knew Mr. Roberts had a half sister that he met twice. He didn't recall her name. Tommy told me Mr. Roberts was a nice kid that grew up in this area. He said Jacob went to Milwaukie High School and thought Mr. Roberts did too.

Tommy said Mr. Roberts like to skate board and ride bikes. He was an active kid and had a great personality. He said Mr. Roberts was always in a good mood and never saw him upset, although he said sometimes Mr. Roberts was hard to read.

I asked Tommy what Mr. Roberts did at Big Bertha's. He said Mr. Roberts made sandwiches. He said Big Bertha's is a sandwich shop in amongst a bunch of bars so they provide late night food to people leaving the bars.

I asked Tommy if Mr. Roberts was still working at Big Bertha's at the time of the shooting. He said no. He said Jacob planned on moving to Hawaii. He said a couple weeks ago Jacob came in and told everyone he was moving to Hawaii. He said Mr. Roberts seemed really happy about the move and sold all his possessions. Tommy said he didn't know why Mr. Roberts was moving there and didn't mention any family or friends there. Tommy told me Mr. Roberts quit last week in anticipation of the move. Tommy said he thought Mr. Roberts was supposed to leave for Hawaii this last Saturday.

Tommy told me he knew Mr. Roberts had also received an inheritance from his grandfather some time ago, but didn't know anything else about it. I asked him if Mr. Roberts had a girlfriend. He said he used to, but apparently he broke up with her because of the move to Hawaii. He said her name is Bonnie, but didn't know anything about her.

I asked Tommy if he knew if Mr. Roberts had any mental health issues or if he seemed depressed or concerned about anything. He told me not that he knew of. He said the only thing he knew was that Mr. Roberts had eczema and used some sort of cream for it.



I asked Jacob about the last time he saw Mr. Roberts. He said Mr. Roberts dropped by his house on Monday or Tuesday of last week. He said they were just hanging out and he taught Mr. Roberts how to juggle. He said Mr. Roberts said he was training a new guy at Big Bertha's to take his spot because he was moving to Hawaii. He said Mr. Roberts told him his last day was supposed to be Friday.

Jacob told me he called Mr. Roberts on Monday (the 10th) to see how he was and how Hawaii was. He said he didn't get an answer. I asked him what Mr. Roberts phone number is and he told me [REDACTED] asked him what kind of phone Mr. Roberts has and he told me he didn't know, but thought it was a smart phone.

I asked him if Mr. Roberts ever talked about guns or shooting. He said he thought so. He said he thought Mr. Roberts used to go shooting. He also thought Mr. Roberts owns a handgun, but never saw him with it.

I asked Jacob if there was anyone else he thought we should talk to about Mr. Roberts and he said probably Tyler Eheler. He thought Mr. Roberts and Tyler Eheler still keep in touch.

I asked Jacob why Mr. Roberts said he was moving to Hawaii. He said he thought maybe Mr. Roberts was originally from Hawaii and Mr. Roberts said he had a place to stay to test it out and see how he liked it. He said Mr. Roberts didn't mention how he had a contact there or who it was.

I asked Jacob if he knew of any jobs Mr. Roberts had. He said he thought Mr. Roberts was training to fight wildfires. He said he didn't know where he was doing this at. He said Mr. Roberts got hurt and had to give that up. He said he helped Mr. Roberts get a job at the bakery and then at Big Bertha's.

I asked Jacob if there was anything else he thought I should know and he told me he wanted me to know that the Jacob he knew was a really awesome guy and he had no idea why he would do this or what happened to cause Mr. Roberts to do this.



I searched a small closet. In the closet I found a black cell phone that is listed as item #9 on the attached PIC. The phone was in a drawer under a bunch of clothes and appeared old.


Also in the closet I found a small sandwich sized Rubbermaid type container that had smaller caliber ammunition in it (item #6), a black nylon police type duty belt (item #7) and a small package of ear protection (item #8).

Across the room from the closet was a built in hutch/closet. The top portion of this hutch had glass doors. The glass in the doors slid from side to side to allow the doors to open. Both panes of glass were moved to the right and I saw a social security card with the name Jacob Tyler Roberts on it on the bottom shelf on the left side. I seized this and it is item #4.

In the lower portion of the cupboard that wood doors. On the lower shelf of this portion I found a single orange foamie type ear plug. I seized it and it is item #5 on the PIC.

We completed our search and gave Mr. Dahrens a copy of the attached PIC. Det. Pearson transported the evidence. We all cleared the house at about 2:00 AM.



NARRATIVE:

On December 12, 2012 at about 12:00 PM I was asked to contact two people in the lobby that wanted to provide information about the shooting. I went to the lobby and met Tommy and Jacob Illk. They told me they were friends of Mr. Roberts and would like to talk to me. I asked them if it would be okay if I spoke with them separately and they told me that was fine.

I first met with Tommy Illk privately in an interview room. I asked Tommy for identifying information, which he provided. I asked him how he knew Mr. Roberts. He told me they were friends and worked together at Big Bertha's. He told me he had known Mr. Roberts for about two years. He said he met Mr. Roberts through his brother Jacob. He told me Mr. Roberts and Jacob are childhood friends.

I asked Tommy what he knew about Mr. Roberts. He said he knew Mr. Roberts was adopted and doesn't have a lot of family. He said he knew Mr. Roberts had a half sister that he met twice. He didn't recall her name. Tommy told me Mr. Roberts was a nice kid that grew up in this area. He said Jacob went to Milwaukie High School and thought Mr. Roberts did too.

Tommy said Mr. Roberts like to skate board and ride bikes. He was an active kid and had a great personality. He said Mr. Roberts was always in a good mood and never saw him upset, although he said sometimes Mr. Roberts was hard to read.

I asked Tommy what Mr. Roberts did at Big Bertha's. He said Mr. Roberts made sandwiches. He said Big Bertha's is a sandwich shop in amongst a bunch of bars so they provide late night food to people leaving the bars.

I asked Tommy if Mr. Roberts was still working at Big Bertha's at the time of the shooting. He said no. He said Tommy planned on moving to Hawaii. He said a couple weeks ago Tommy came in and told everyone he was moving to Hawaii. He said Mr. Roberts seemed really happy about the move and sold all his possessions. Tommy said he didn't know why Mr. Roberts was moving there and didn't mention any family or friends there. Tommy told me Mr. Roberts quit last week in anticipation of the move. Tommy said he thought Mr. Roberts was supposed to leave for Hawaii this last Saturday.

Tommy told me he knew Mr. Roberts had also received an inheritance from his grandfather some time ago, but didn't know anything else about it. I asked him if Mr. Roberts had a girlfriend. He said he used to, but apparently he broke up with her because of the move to Hawaii. He said her name is Bonnie, but didn't know anything about her.

I asked Tommy if he knew if Mr. Roberts had any mental health issues or if he seemed depressed or concerned about anything. He told me not that he knew of. He said the only thing he knew was that Mr. Roberts had eczema and used some sort of cream for it.




I asked Tommy when the last time he saw Mr. Roberts was and he told me he saw him this last Friday. He said Mr. Roberts stopped by Big Bertha's to say good bye to everyone because he was supposed to leave Saturday.

I asked Tommy if he knew of anyone else I should talk to that knew Mr. Roberts. He said just his brother Jacob. Tommy told me Mr. Roberts didn't let on that anything was wrong and had everyone convinced he was moving to Hawaii.

I asked Tommy if Mr. Roberts ever talked about guns or shooting. He said Mr. Roberts did talk about shooting and target practice. He said he thought he had a handgun and that he would go out and shoot with his friends. He didn't know anything else about this.

I asked Tommy if there was anything else he thought I should know and he said no. He just felt compelled to come and talk to us and share anything he could to help. When I walked Tommy back to the lobby I learned he was actually the owner of Big Bertha's. He told me he had just recently sold it. He said it was just him and Mr. Roberts that worked there and it is just a small shop.

NARRATIVE:

On December 11, 2012 around 7:30 PM I was asked to go to PSTC to contact the family of Steven Forsyth and notify them of his death. I was told they were waiting at PSTC. I arrived and contacted Sgt. Brisben who told me the family was waiting in a private room. Two advocates from Victim's Assistance accompanied me into the room where I saw seven people. I learned that four of the seven were from TIP. I also identified Paul Kemp, Carla Forsyth and Katie Hughes.

I advised the family of Mr. Forsyth's passing. They were devastated and cried. I apologized for having to deliver this horrible news as well as having to bother them with some important questions about what happened when they were at the mall. Mrs. Forsyth and Katie told me they had just been at the mall talking to Mr. Forsyth. They explained to me he had opened a kiosk there recently called Coastems. They told me his kiosk is located outside upper level Macy's.

They told me they had visited with Mr. Forsyth for a while and then went into Macy's to look around. They told me they were on the east side of the store near the perfume area. They said they heard gun shot and hit the floor. They told me the shots were so loud and there were so many they couldn't count. They told me it didn't stop for a long time before it went quiet.

They told me a store employee came and took them to a storage closet to hide. While in the closet they were calling and texting Mr. Forsyth and didn't get an answer. They told me when they left Mr. Forsyth he was talking to his father Ron on the telephone. It had only been seconds since they had left him before the shots fired out.



I asked the family if they were familiar with Jacob Roberts who was about 22 years old. They asked me if he was the shooter and I said he was. I asked them if there was any reason they could think of that Mr. Roberts would want to shoot Mr. Forsyth and they said no.

I explained to the family what would be happening with Mr. Forsyth and told them they should be hearing from the medical examiner's office, but if they hadn't they were welcome to call me. Mrs. Forsyth told me her husband's computer; Ipad, phone and keys were all at the kiosk. She told me his phone is a flip phone and the service is through Verizon.

Mr. Kemp told me he had not been at the mall, but Mrs. Forsyth called him and told him what had happened so he drove to be with her. I gave the family my card and told them they could call me with any questions or concerns. I also asked them if they recalled anything to please contact me.

NARRATIVE:**(Respond to active shooter call)**

On 12/11/12, at about 1535 hrs, I responded to the area of the Clackamas Town Center (CTC) located 12110 SE 82nd Ave, Happy Valley, Clackamas County, Oregon, in response to CCOM dispatching patrol units to the mall on an active shooter situation.

Upon arrival, I blocked off traffic entering the mall on the west side, SE 82nd Ave near SE Sunnyside Road, west of the entrance into the Sears store.

CCOM provided me a description of the suspect at the time, a male wearing black hooded jacket, black pants and a white hockey style mask. While watching individuals exiting the mall area onto the street, I noticed a white male adult wearing a black hooded jacket that was pulled over his head, wearing boots and black tactical style pants and black gloves, jogging out of the area and appeared to have a distressed look on his face.

(Contact with suspicious person at CTC, Chris De Meerleer)

I was able to catch up to the subject in the parking lot of the Dairy Queen. From about 100 feet away I yelled out to the male to stop and put his hands up, as I had my department issued shotgun at the low ready position, wearing a jacket with Sheriff's Office monikers on the front and back.

I identified myself as a member of the sheriff's office. The male immediately turned around and looked at me and dropped to his knees putting his hands in the air. I approached the male and provided him instructions to put his hands behind his back, which he complied with. As soon as other CCSO members arrived at my location, I grabbed the subject's hands behind his back in a control hold (fingers) and performed a cursor pat down of the individual's outer clothing finding no indications the subject was armed and/or concealing a weapon.

While patting down the individual, a Dairy Queen employee came and out and told me the individual was an employee. I noticed when I was patting down the male; under his hooded sweatshirt he was wearing a polo style shirt with the Dairy Queen emblem on the chest.

I had the male subject stand up, while I looked inside his wallet and located some identification. I provided CCOM the subject's Oregon driver license number [REDACTED]. I was able to identify the male subject as Christopher Adam De Meerleer, with the date of birth 8/1/1988. Chris told me he was on his way to the work and was at the mall when the shooting occurred. I told Chris he matched the description of the shooter and that was why I was contacting him and he said "I understand."

I thanked Chris for his cooperation and returned to the mall entrance off of SE 82nd Ave.

A while later, CTC Security set up a barrier across the intersection and Lt. Davis arrived at my location. I requested Lt. Davis replace me, as I was going to the Command Post (Max platform on the Northeast side of the mall) to assist in interviewing witnesses.

Upon arrival, several investigators from CCSO and outside agencies and I began escorting individuals one by one, into the CTC Transit Police building and took their statements and information regarding the shooting.



(David Bragg interview)

At about 1709 hrs I made contact with David Bragg, date of birth [REDACTED], and took his statements and information. David provided me his Oregon driver license number. I documented his ODL number [REDACTED] for my report. David told me he worked at Champs Sports inside the mall, which was across the way from Macy's Home Store on the upper level.

David said while working he heard five gunshots, "pop, pop, pop, pop, pop." David said people were running and screaming towards JC Penny. David said he then heard like 10 more rapid fire gunshots, "but a lot faster than the first shots that were fired." David said he didn't hear any more shots, waited for a few minutes and walked to the front of the store and saw a magazine lying on the ground (banana shape) in front of the Macy's Home Store. David said he exited the mall out the entrance between Macy's Home Store and Forever 21 on the North side.

David said he did not see the shooter and only heard the shoots being fired before getting out of the mall.

This concluded my interview with David.

(Rick Data interview)

At about 1715 hrs, I talked with Rick Lee Data, date of birth [REDACTED], and took his statements and information. Rick provided me his Oregon driver license. I documented his ODL number [REDACTED] for my report.

Rick told me, he was at the mall with his wife Elisa (being interviewed by other investigator) and was at the directory kiosk in front of Macy's when they heard a loud bang but at first didn't know what it was. Rick said he then saw a male walking towards them from Macy's store wearing a hooded pullover jacket, black pants, wearing a white hard plastic mask. Rick said the man had a "long assault rifle, with a clip inside the rifle," and appeared to be "randomly looking around shooting at people." Rick said they were about 25 feet from the shooter crouched behind the directory kiosk and didn't think the shooter could see them.

Rick said he was keeping his wife down behind the directory kiosk when he noticed the shooter was about 10 feet from where they were at. Rick said the shooter turned around and took aim on a guy who was about 6 feet away near another kiosk and the upper floor railing. Rick said the shooter, aimed and fired one shoot at the guy's head. Rick said the guy fell to the ground and there was blood coming from his head.

Rick said the shooter continued to walk past them towards JC Penny firing shots. Rick said once the shooter got passed them he noticed he dropped a "clip," and then walked back to pick it up. Rick said at that moment they went around the directory kiosk and ran back inside Macy's and exited the mall. Rick told me "I thought we were going to die."

Rick said the shooter was "walking like a normal person just doing it." Rick said he never heard the shooter say anything and/or yell out any commands.

This concluded my interview with Rick.



Sometime later, CCSO Sgt. Mathew Swanson requested I head over to Claim Jumpers and make contact with Abraham Olvera, an employee and take his statements. CCSO Detective Paul Wade and I went to Claim Jumpers and talked with Abraham Mosses Olvera, date of birth [REDACTED]

(Abraham Olvera interview)

Abraham told us he did not see the shooter, but heard the gunshots. Abraham said he was on the lower level near the Sprint store when he heard the gun fire, "maybe six rounds." Abraham said he was on his way out of the mall through Macy's when he noticed a woman had fallen. Abraham said he helped the woman up and get out of the store with her children, however when she fell her keys must have fallen out of her purse. Abraham said he picked up her keys but could not find the woman before he lost her. Abraham said he gave the keys to his manager, who I later learned gave the keys to CCSO Civil Deputy Marc Nunn.

This concluded my contact with Abraham.

I located Deputy Nunn on scene, and asked him about the keys. Deputy Nunn advised he would complete a PIC and put the keys into the CCSO Property Room as found property.

(Contact with Sean Cates, owner of stolen AR-15 that was used in shooting 82/Flavel)

Sometime later Portland Police Bureau Sgt. Mark Georgioff requested our assistance at SE 82nd Ave and SE Flavel. According to Sgt Georgioff a PPB Officer was at the location with a guy wanting to report his AR-15 rifle as stolen. According to Sgt. Georgioff the RP's AR appears to be similar to the AR-15 rifle used in the shooting, and the RP's friend that stole it, appears to match the description of the shooter.

Upon arrival Detective Wade and I meet with PPB Officer Carroll. Officer Carroll advised the reporting party Sean Cates, wanted to file a theft report for his AR-15 rifle that was stolen early today. Carroll advised the occurrence location for the theft was in Multnomah County. We requested Officer Carroll take the initial paper for the incident as it occurred in MC, however we would handle the interview. Officer Carroll provided me PPB incident number 2012-107960 for the theft report, and advised he would complete a report and forward me a copy.

I made contact with Sean Cates, date of birth [REDACTED] and took his statements and information. Sean provided me his Oregon driver license. I documented his ODL number [REDACTED] for the report.

Sean advised that he believes his friend, identified as Jacob Tyler Roberts, date of birth [REDACTED], stole his AR-15 from his residence located at [REDACTED] Multnomah County, Oregon, between 0700 hrs – 1600 hrs today (12/11/12).



Sean provided me the paperwork for the "Stag" Arms model 1 AR-15 .223 CAL rifle, with the serial number 137603, which he purchased from the gun brokers in March of 2011, according to the paperwork, as seen here to the right. →

Sean said he took the stock issued site off the AR and put on a "Red Dot scope." Sean said his AR had a collapsible stock, and a stock suppressor.

Sean said he was also missing one magazine that contained 20 .223 CAL rounds that were seated inside the AR when it was stolen.

Sean told me that after discovering his AR-15 was missing (around 4pm) he immediately thought Jacob took it. Sean said since he had to be at work at 5pm, he would talk to Jacob later about the rifle, and didn't file a report with the police.

Sean told me he got to work (Mama Mia's on SE 2nd and Morrison) and told a co-worker, Jason Carter about Jacob stealing his AR-15. Sean said that Jason left but called him some time later in his shift and asked him if he heard about the shooting at the Town Center. Sean said that Jason told him the shooter used an AR-15 assault rifle. Sean said he didn't know exactly why "but thought it was him," referring to Jacob.

Sean said at this point he felt he needed to call the police, but didn't know what to do. Sean told me that he lost his cell phone and believes it was inside Jacob's car. Sean said he didn't know where the police station was so he drove to the 7-11 on SE 82nd Ave and SE Flavel and called Portland Police Bureau.



Based on the information Sean provided about his AR-15 and Jacob, I requested Detective Wade contact Sgt. Anderson with Jacob's information and the serial number off Sean's stolen AR-15.

Sean told me he has known Jacob for about a year and met him through a co-worker. Sean told me Jacob drives a green 1996 Jetta. Sean told me last night he met up with Jacob around 12:15 in the morning at Putters Bar and Grill and had some drinks. Sean said after leaving Putters they stopped at the 7-11 on SE 52nd and SE Woodstock, and purchased three .22 oz beers. Sean was not sure of the time; however alcohol is not sold after 0230 hrs in Oregon, so Sean thought it had to be sometime between 0100 and 0230 hrs.

Sean said they hung out at his house drinking beer and shooting pool, before going to Denny's (82nd Ave across from CTC) around 3:00 or 4:00 am.

Sean said when they returned Jacob went to bed and slept on the leather couch in his room as seen in the photograph below. Sean said he stayed up until 6:00 or 7:00 am before going to bed and didn't get up until 4:00 pm. Sean told me that he had no idea when Jacob left that morning as he did not get up until 4 pm and by then Jacob and his car were gone.

Sean told me, he has not seen nor talked with Jacob since. Sean did not know where Jacob's car was.

I asked Sean if they were doing any illegal drugs and at first he said "no," however later said that "we smoked a bowl," referring to smoking marijuana. Sean said they shared a bowl of weed and that was all. Sean said as far as he knows Jacob was not using and/or taking any other type of illegal and/or prescription drugs.

Sean said when he woke up; he noticed his AR-15, that was behind a white shelf in his closet area was missing, as seen here to the right in the photograph, which I later took ~~white~~ standing inside Sean's bedroom.

Sean said he didn't notice anything else missing including his other guns, and ammunition, other than the one, 20 round .223 magazine, that was seated in the rifle when it was stolen.



Sean said that he noticed one of his roommate's guitars was out of the case and the guitar case was missing. I took a photograph of the guitar where it was last seen inside the case, as seen here to the right. Sean told me that maybe Jacob put his AR-15 in Jason's (Jason Komlòfske) ~~guitar case~~ in order to get it out of his house.

I asked Sean if there was anything suspicious about Jacob's behavior that night and Sean said no. Sean said that Jacob was moving to Hawaii and was getting rid of his property, selling it on Craigslist. Sean said that Jacob gave him his XBOX and several games and told him that he was going on the run.

Sean later told me that Jacob confided in him that he wasn't really going to Hawaii but didn't want anyone else to know, which Sean thought was strange because Jacob had just given him the XBOX.

Sean told me that Jacob said he needed to get out of town. Sean said he wasn't sure why Jacob needed to leave town and Jacob would not tell him anything further as to why he needed to leave town.

Sean said at some point in the night Jacob told him that he needed to get a gun. Sean said that he asked Jacob why, and Jacob refused to tell him, and Sean said he didn't push the matter.

Sean said that at some point during the night he pulled out his AR-15 and Jacob was holding it. Sean said that Jacob knew where he kept the rifle and had seen it and handled it before that night.

Sean described his phone as a 3GS Galaxy black in color. Sean said his screen was cracked and looked like a "spider web." Sean wasn't sure but thought he lost it in Jacob's Jetta between the time they went to Denny's and came home.

Sean told me that Jacob did not leave anything behind at his place other than the XBOX that he gave him.

I asked Sean what Jacob was wearing the last time he saw him. Sean said he was wearing a black fedora hat, grey long sleeve shirt but not thick like a sweatshirt, blue denim jeans, black Nike shoes with green trim.

Sean described Jacob as a dark skin male, about 5'7" tall, with a chin piercing and black hair. Sean was unaware of any tattoos Jacob might have.

Sean said that Jacob was "fit" and was not a violent person.



Detective Wade showed Sean a Department of Motor Vehicles photograph of Jacob Tyler Roberts, date of birth [REDACTED] taken in November of 2011, as seen here to the right. Sean said that was the same Jacob, he had been talking about. →



Sean was unaware where Jacob was living and said he had never been to his place. Sean told me that Jacob's parents died a while back and that he didn't have any brothers or sisters. Sean said Jacob grew up in the Milwaukie area, but didn't think he lived in Milwaukie any more. Sean told me that Jacob works at "Big Berthas," off SE Hawthorne, between the "Bar of the Gods" and the "Water trough."

Sean was unaware of any recent girlfriend Jacob had. Sean said Jacob's ex-girlfriend's name was something similar to Hanna Sansburn.

I asked Sean about any type of white mask he might have had at his house that was missing. Sean was unaware of any type of white mask. Sean said that he never saw Jacob with any white mask.

I asked Sean if Jacob confided in him about planning some type of shooting at the CTC and he said "no." I asked Sean if he was aware of any plans Jacob had that involved him going on a shooting spree at CTC and he said "no." I asked Sean if he was involved in planning a shooting at the CTC and he said "no."

I advised Sean that I wanted to go to his house and take a look around. Sean told me he wanted to cooperate in anyway possible and that we have his consent to look around the common areas of the house and his bedroom.

Sean provided me the names of his roommates, Joseph Blumenberg, Jason Komlofske, Riley Lundgren, Brendan McNeeley, and Ryan Sweeney. Sean was unaware of his roommate's whereabouts.

I provided Officer Carroll Jacob's information and asked him to search Portland's database for any police contact with Jacob, which might help identify the license plate on Jacob's green 96 Jetta.

A short time later, Officer Carroll located a traffic stop associated to Jacob that resulted in Jacob receiving a citation, in July of 2012 (Portland Police Bureau citation number PR00509275). Officer Carroll told me the vehicle information associated to the citation was a green four-door 1996 Jetta with Oregon license plate number VCZ648, which returned registered to Jacob.

I contacted Sgt. Anderson and passed along Jacob's vehicle information.

I confirmed with Sean again, that he was giving us consent to search his bedroom and the common areas of the home for any possible evidence related to the theft of his AR-15 and the shooting at CTC and Sean said, yes, and that he wanted to cooperate in anyway possible.



(Consent search at Sean Cates' residence; seize evidence related to stolen AR)

Upon arrival of Oregon State Police Trooper Detective Patti Rhodes and Trooper Meyer, we followed Sean and Detective Wade in Sean's vehicle back to Sean's residence, [REDACTED] Portland, Oregon.

Sean walked us downstairs to his bedroom and the poolroom where he and Jacob were hanging out in the early morning hours of Tuesday 12/11/12. I took photographs of the poolroom and bedroom areas (see attached photographs for details):

The image below to the left shows Sean's bed; the image below to the right shows Sean's couch where Jacob was sleeping;


The box on the green couch contained the XBOX gaming system Jacob gave to Sean.

Behind the green couch, I located Sean's other rifle and an empty rifle case that Sean confirmed was the case for his AR. The serial number 137603 on the rifle case, matched the serial number on the paperwork for the AR, that Sean showed us early when he purchased his AR.



Inside the empty AR case I found a full box of ammunition, as seen here below to the right. Sean was not sure if he had the same ammunition loaded in the magazine that was seated inside his AR when Jacob stole it.

The image below to the left shows Sean's 9mm handgun on the shelf inside the closet area, along with a secondary AR magazine loaded. Sean was pretty sure that the ammunition in the magazine left behind was the same ammunition that was inside the magazine that was seated inside his AR when Jacob stole it.



Detective Wade seized the loaded AR magazine, the empty AR case with box of ammunition, the XBOX gaming system along with the controllers, power supply and five XBOX games, and Sean's paperwork showing the receipt and details to the purchase. Detective Wade provided Sean a copy of the PIC.

I provided Sean a business card with my contact information and advised him to contact me if he had any questions. I explained to Sean that over the next few days Detective Wade and I would be attempting to contact his other roommates and take their statements and information regarding Jacob.

Later Detective Wade took the seized property to the CCSO Property Room where it was logged in as evidence.

Detective Wade, Trooper Rhodes and Meyer, and Officer Carroll and I changed our location to Big Berthas, located at 4809 SE Hawthorne BLVD, Portland, Oregon. Upon arrival I noticed the business was closed. An unknown citizen approached us and advised the business changed ownership hands and would be closed for a few days.

(Assist with search warrant at Jacob's residence and talk with Jacob's roommates)

On 12/12/12 at about 0115 hrs, I assisted other CCSO investigators execute a search warrant at Jacob Robert's residence located at [REDACTED] Portland, Oregon. At the location were Jacob's roommates, Jamie Eheler, date of birth [REDACTED] and Christopher Dahrens, date of birth [REDACTED]

Prior to executing the search warrant, at about 0117 hrs, I read the search warrant to Jamie and Chris. I read to Jamie and Chris a CCSO "Consent to Search" green card. Chris signed and dated the card. I signed and dated as the witness. I filled out a PIC and placed the consent to search card



as item #1 on the PIC. I later provided Chris and Jamie a signed copy of the search warrant for their records.

While other investigators searched the house I stayed in the living room with Jamie and Chris. Chris mentioned to me that as far as he knew, Jacob was moving to Hawaii, however, the date Jacob planned on leaving continually changed. Chris told me that Jacob had been selling off his property and said he thought his car was listed on Craigslist for sale.

Chris provided me Jacob's phone number [REDACTED]

Chris and Jamie told me that Jacob's ex-girlfriend name was Bonnie; however they were unable to provide me her last name.

When I asked Chris and Jamie if they know who Sean Cates was they both said no. Chris and Jamie said that Jacob and lots of friends.

I asked Chris and Jamie about any type of white mask they might have had at the house that was missing. Chris said that Jacob bought a hard white plastic mask for Halloween and thinks it was the same one the news reported the shooter was wearing.

I searched inside a detached shed in the backyard located on the property with negative results. I searched inside a detached garage located on the property with negative results.

This concluded my assistance with the search warrant.

This concluded my portion of the investigation for the day.

(Interview Sean's roommates, Ryan Sweeny, Riley Lundgren)

On 12/12/12 at about 1223 hrs, Detective Wade and I made contact at Sean's residence [REDACTED] Ave, Portland, Oregon, with Sean's roommates, Ryan Sweeney and Joe Blumenberg. I talked with Ryan E Sweeney, date of birth [REDACTED], and took his statements and information, while Detective Wade talked with Joseph Blumenberg (see Detective Wade's report for details).

Ryan told me he does not know Jacob that well. Ryan told me that he had been living at the location for over a year; however, last Friday was really the first time he had ever met Jacob. He said they talked about music and played pool.

Ryan said Jacob had been to the house prior to Friday, however said he just never paid that much attention to him.

Ryan said he remember Jacob being at the house Monday night (Tuesday morning 12/11/12). He said that Sean was hanging out with Jacob. Ryan said he was watching a movie with some of the other roommates, while Sean and Jacob were downstairs playing pool. Ryan said he didn't hang out with them.



Ryan said he left that morning about 10:00 am and returned home and then left again for work around 2:30 pm. Ryan said that he didn't know if Jacob was at the house or not and did not recall seeing his vehicle. Ryan told me he didn't think Jacob was at the house when he got up (10:00 am).

Ryan told me he heard from Jason, one of his other roommates that his guitar case was missing.

Ryan told me "I just really didn't know the kid." Ryan said he had not seen nor heard from Jacob since Tuesday.

I provided Ryan my business card with my contact information. This concluded my contact with Ryan.

On 12/12/12 at about 1305 hrs, I made phone contact with Riley Lundgren, date of birth [REDACTED] and took his statements and information. Riley told me he really didn't know Jacob, only that he was friends with Sean and worked at Big Berthas. Riley told me, he thought Jacob seemed like a "pretty normal guy."

Riley said he was at the house on Tuesday night when Jacob came over with Sean. Riley said he was watching a movie with Ryan and didn't hang out with Sean and Jacob. Riley told me Sean and Jacob left the house around 3:00 or 4:00 am in the morning and he went to bed before they returned.

Riley told me that he got up around 2:00 pm and that Jacob was gone by the time he woke up. Riley told me had not seen nor heard from Jacob since Tuesday.

Ryan told me that he was one of the last roommates to use Jason's (Jason Komlofske) guitar and he was sure he put it in the case; however, the case was now missing. Ryan described the guitar case a blue hard leather case.

This concluded my contact with Riley.

This concluded my portion of the investigation for the day.

(Phone contact with Sean Cates about stolen AR)

On 12/13/12 I contacted Sean Cates by phone. Sean told me that Jacob had tried to sell him his car and told me he thought it was listed on Craigslist for sale.

I advised Sean that we have been unable to locate his cell phone. Sean was sure that he had the phone when he returned home from Putters Bar and Grill and the last time he realized it was missing was when he got home from Denny's. Sean said that when he calls it, it still rings. Sean told me if it was not in Jacob's car he was unsure of its whereabouts.

I asked Sean if we find his cell phone, would I have consent to search the phone. Sean told me that I had consent to search his phone and again said he wanted to cooperate in anyway possible.

I asked Sean when was the last time he fired his AR. Sean told me, he had not fired his AR since late spring/early summer, maybe six months ago and didn't even clean it. Sean said he thought there



might be some rust on the gun. Sean told me, he did not want his AR back after knowing what happened.

I confirmed with Sean the various locations and approximate times he was at with Jacob on Tuesday 12/11/12. Sean said he was Putters Bar and Grill, went to the 7-11 on SE Woodstock and ate at the Denny's across the street from CTC.

(Interview Denny's employees, Cary Fuller and Nicole Chapman and seize video footage)

On 12/13/12 at about 1130 hrs, I made contact with the General Manager, Cary Fuller, date of birth [REDACTED], at the Denny's located at 12101 SE 82nd Ave, Happy Valley, Oregon.

I provided Cary the details to my contact and he advised they do have video surveillance at the location.

I provided Cary the approximate times. I know from reviewing the video surveillance footage at about 3:03 am on Tuesday 12/11/12, Sean and Jacob entered the Denny's and were seated at a table. At about 3:50 hrs, Sean and Jacob paid with cash (left on table) and exited the restaurant. I was able to recognize Sean and Jacob as it was just the two of them, and from Sean's previous description of what Jacob was wearing that night; to include a black fedora hat that Jacob wore while inside Denny's.

I know from viewing the video, it did not appear that Sean nor Jacob came into the restaurant with anything in their hands, and it did not look like they were reviewing anything while sitting in the booth.

According to Cary the server that night was Nicole Chapman. While at the store I called Nicole Chapman, date of birth [REDACTED] and took her statements and information.

Nicole told me she remembers the two guys. She said they were "really nice guys." I asked Nicole if she thought they were looking at maps and/or going over something while sitting at the booth and she said no. She said they were acting normal and there was nothing suspicious about them.

This concluded my phone contact with Nicole.

Cary advised he would burn a copy of the video surveillance footage onto a CD-r. I filled out a PIC and provided Cary the pink copy, and seized the CD-r as evidence.

I asked Cary if anyone turned in a cell phone to their lost and found in the last few days. After checking a lock box he said no.

I later submitted the CD-r into the CCSO Property Room as evidence. At this time I have not submitted the CD-r to Joyce Nagy CCSO Forensic Artist, for further analyzing.

(Interview with Putters Bar and Grill employee, Tyler Jensen)

On 12/13/12 at about 1330 hrs, I made contact with Tyler Jensen, date of birth [REDACTED], Kitchen Manger for Putters Bar and Grill, located at 4506 SE Woodstock, Portland, Oregon 97202.



I provided Tyler the details to my contact. Tyler advised that Morgan Gates was bartending that night; however she was not working today. Tyler told me they do not have any video surveillance inside the bar. I asked Tyler if anyone turned in a cell phone to their lost and found in the last few days and he said no.

I provide Tyler my business card and contact information and asked him to have Morgan call me when she returns to work.

This concluded my contact at the location.

(Interview with 7-11 employees, Renuka Magar and Nirmal Shrestha)

On 12/13/12 at about 1335 hrs, I made contact at the 7-11 located at 5122 SE Woodstock BLVD, Portland, Oregon 97202, with an employee Renuka Magar, date of birth [REDACTED]

I provided Renuka the details to my contact. Renuka told me she was not working that night but thought maybe her Manager was. Renuka advised that her manager, Nirmal Shrestha would not be at the store today. Renu advised they do have video surveillance cameras inside the store.

I asked Renuka if any cellular phones had been turned into their lost and found within the last few days and she said no.

Renuka called her manager, Nirmal and I talked with him over the phone. I requested Nirmal burn a copy of the stores video surveillance footage between 1300 and 1430 hrs, Tuesday 12/11/12, which he agreed to do. I advised him I would leave my contact information with Renuka and to contact me when the CD-r was ready to be picked up.

This concluded my contact at the location with Renuka.

This concluded my portion of the investigation for the day.

(Interview with Putters Bar and Grill employee, Morgan Gates)

On 12/14/12 at about 1100 hrs, I received a phone call from Morgan Gates, date of birth [REDACTED] Morgan told me, she was bartending Monday night, early Tuesday morning (12/11/12) at Putters Bar and Grill.

Morgan said Jacob came into the bar around midnight and a short time later his friend (referring to Sean) showed up. She said they had some shots, drank beer and played pool. She said they left the bar around 1:30 am on foot and walked down the street.

I asked Morgan if anyone else was with them and she said no. She said they were talking with a few regular girls in the back poolroom but that was about it. I asked Morgan if they appeared to be reviewing and/or going over maps and she said "no, nothing like that." She said they were laughing and drinking and talking with others. Morgan described the two as "polite...sweet...and nice."



Morgan told me, she did not recognize Jacob as anyone she had seen before. Morgan said that she was at the mall entrance, outside of Macy's when the shooting occurred, and once they noticed people were running out of the store, she left the area. Morgan said later that night she saw a photograph of Jacob on the news and thought that it was the same guy from the bar.

I asked Morgan if anyone turned in a cellular phone to their lost and found and she said she checked everywhere and no cell phones have been turned in.

This concluded my contact with Morgan.

(Google search results on Jacob's cell phone)

On 12/14/12 I conducted a Google search on Jacob Robert's cellular phone number [REDACTED]. Upon review of the results I found a Craigslist posting for Jacob's "96 jetta gls." I printed off the posting and attached it to the report for review.

I found several other results showing Jacob's phone number being associated with the sale of various items to include XBOX and a sectional. Most of the Craigslist posting had expired. I cut and pasted several of the for sale advertisement images, onto a word document and attached a copy to the report for review.

I know from talking with individuals that knew Jacob they said he was selling his belongings because he was planning to get out of town and move to Hawaii.

This concluded my portion of the investigation related to the shooting at CTC.

I attached a diagram, which I created documenting Rick Data's statements as to where he and his wife were at; when he observed the suspect (Roberts) shoot the victim (Forsyth) in the head. At the time I interviewed Rick I was unable to show Rick a map/diagram of the mall showing the exact location of the kiosks in relation to the mall layout and where he was standing.

ACTION RECOMMEND:

Obtain 7-11 video surveillance footage and PPB Theft report from Officer Carroll for the stolen AR.

Attach special report to CCSO Case Agents, Detective Michael Copenhaver and Jeff Burlew's original report.







NARRATIVE:

On 12-11-2012 at about 3:30pm I was working in my cubicle at the Brooks building when I heard Deputy Kishpaugh state there was an active shooter at the Clackamas Town Center. I left my cubicle and told Sergeant Kollias there was an active shooter as I exited the building to my car.

I drove to the East end of the mall and parked at the North doors to JC Penny where I put on my SWAT heavy vest. As Deputy Kishpaugh and I were entering the store we were joined by Sgt. Kollias, Detective Cate.

We entered the JC Penny on the upper floor through the northeast doors and contacted an employee inside. The male employee was certain Mr. Roberts did not get into their store. He said they closed and locked all of the doors. The employee went with us to the large roll up door to the second floor of the mall which he opened. At about 3:40pm we entered the central common area of the mall and began quickly moving forward listening for signs of where Mr. Roberts was. We came to a set of doors to the employee corridors prior to reaching Macy's Home store. We now had Deputy Eason, Deputy O'Keeffe and two OSP Troopers with us.

We entered the corridor as a large cell and cleared to a set of stairs where we all went down to the first floor. At this intersection I went right with Detective Cate, Deputy O'Keeffe, Deputy Eason and one OSP Officer into corridor 2. We made our way to the last section of the corridor which would have brought us back into the lower level of the common area of the mall right in front of JC Penny.

As we rounded the corner into this last section I saw a male on the floor near the doors to the common area. There was an assault rifle on the floor next to the male as well as a puddle of blood. We slowly made our way to the male while commands were given. Once I was closer I could see a large hole in the top of Mr. Roberts' head. At this time it was evident that he was deceased. I also saw a white mask on the floor in front of his body.

At about 3:51pm I got on the radio to advise command and dispatch that we located a male that appeared to be the shooting suspect. I broadcast the male was deceased and that he had an assault rifle and white mask. Captain Layng, Incident Commander, requested that two people remain with Mr. Robert's body while the rest



of us continued to check for other suspects and injured people. Deputies Eason and O'Keeffe remained with the body.

The OSP Trooper, Detective Cate and I carefully walked around the body so we did not disturb any evidence as we exited the corridor into the common area of the mall. At this point we waited briefly until we were joined by Lieutenant Smith and other officers from various agencies. As we were making a plan to fan out we learned Sgt. Coleman was working toward us with another hunting cell. We waited for them to join us and then split into four smaller teams.

We planned to have the four teams split up with two teams on the lower floor, one going down each side, and two on the upper floor doing the same thing as we pushed forward together. I went upstairs with officers from various agencies and pushed forward on the right, North, side of the upper level. As we pushed forward I yelled into businesses that were secured making sure there were no injuries and telling the citizens to remain inside until another team came to get them out.

After moving forward for a short time we came to another cell of officers that were on the South side of the upper level. Deputies Nikolai and Bigler were in this cell with other officers. As we moved further ahead I heard officers behind us getting employees and customers out of stores and getting them out of the mall.

Once we arrived at the food court area I saw officers ahead of us to the West. I also saw what I later learned was Mr. Forsyth's body under a blue blanket on the South side of the upper level in front of Macy's. I helped clear several of the food restaurants in the food court.

At about 4:43pm I heard Captain Layng ask that any non-uniformed personnel exit the mall while uniformed personnel set up in strong points. I exited the mall and went to the Command Post that was stationed near the Tri Met parking garage at the East end of the Town Center.

After a few minutes I was called into the Command Post and asked where Mr. Roberts' body was located. I described the location and was told there were reports of another victim outside of Gentle Dental. I went back into the mall with Sgt. Kollias, Detective Cate and Deputy Kishpaugh. Once we arrived at Gentle Dental, which was on the lower level next to JC Penny and corridor 2. We confirmed that this was Mr. Roberts' body only and there were no other victims in this area. We exited the mall and returned to the Command Post area.

While I was at the Command Post I was contacted by Lieutenant Babst who asked me to take the Crime Scene Investigators to Mr. Roberts' body when they were ready. I waited at the Command Post until we were told we could re-enter the mall.

At about 6:34pm I re-entered the mall through the main mall doors next to the theatres which led to the food court. Deputy Lister was at this door and was starting a crime scene log. After I was logged in I entered the door and waited for Detective Lee, Detective Cate, Detective Nunn, Crime Scene Investigators Finn and Shelly as



well as other Crime Scene Investigators for the Portland Police Bureau and Oregon State Police Forensics Lab.

At this time several SWAT teams were doing a thorough clearing of the mall, but they were still working on the West side of the building. There was still confusion on how many shooters were involved so I remained in my heavy vest and was with the group for security reasons while they video recorded the scenes.

I followed my group, Crystal Bell with the Oregon State Police Forensic Lab, Detective Lee and another Crime Scene Investigator toward Mr. Roberts' body. After the scene was recorded we exited the mall and I returned to my vehicle and took off my vest.

I returned to the Command Post where I was contacted by Sgt. Boell and assigned to contact Ms. Yuille's family about her death, see separate report for details.


I returned to the Brooks building and learned we identified Mr. Roberts as the shooter and that a search warrant was being prepared for his residence. Detectives Erichsen and Shipley were preparing to go to Mr. Roberts' residence to interview his roommates, Chris Dahrens and Jamie Eheler. Detective Bray and I drove in our vehicles to the residence and waited outside to relieve Detectives Erichsen and Shipley if needed while waiting for the search warrant.

At about 10:33pm Detective Erichsen came outside and asked me and Detective Bray to come inside and relieve him and Detective Shipley. We went into the residence where we were introduced to Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler. Detectives Erichsen and Shipley left the residence.

We waited in the residence with Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler until other detectives arrived with the search warrant, see separate report for details.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

Investigation continues. A copy of this report to the case agent.

**ACTION TAKEN
CONTINUED:**

On 12/11/2012 at about 1530 Hrs. I was at Aurora Airport with Deputy Shellans, standing by for an Air Unit Photo flight, to support pre-planning for an upcoming search warrant service.

The airport was weathered in, IFR conditions and we were waiting for the possibility of the low cloud ceiling lifting enough to allow us to fly.

Over the radio we heard CCOM advise of an Active Shooter incident occurring in the Clackamas Town Center Mall and requesting Deputies to respond.

As the weather did not allow us to take the department plane up and fly to the CTC area to provide aerial support, Deputy Shellans and I in our respective patrol vehicles drove to the Clackamas Town Center.

I arrived at about 15:50 hours on the south side of the town center.

At this time the available information indicated there were possibly two or more active shooters in the mall, one was down with a self-inflicted gunshot wound on the other side of the mall.

I took up a position with Deputy Miller and several Portland P.D officers on the Macy's side of the mall at the doors, at this time a white male came running at us.

Multiple firearms were pointed at him; I made the voice commands and had him lay face down on the concrete in front of the entrance door placing him in a felony take down position.

I then hand cuffed him, searched him, got him up on his feet and holding him in a restraint position walked him around a corner of the building.

I found valid ID on him, identifying the subject to be Ben Christensen.

He also had picture ID identifying him to be the manager of Just Sports inside the mall.

After verifying that he was not a suspect in this incident, I stuffed one of my business cards in his pocket, un-handcuffed him and directed him to leave via the south side parking lot.

I then entered the mall with Deputy Miller and the Portland P.D officers as a search team.

**ACTION
CONTINUED:**

Once inside we linked up with another team, Trp. Fosburgh on this one, giving us 3 or 4 three man teams, and begin searching the first floor business(s).

I don't know how many business(s) we went thru nor what the names were.

We reached a point where the bottom floor was secure enough that citizens we had found hiding could be moved out of the store.

Making a daisy chain of officers so we could keep at least one other officer in visual range, we shuttled the civilians out of the store; I was the last one inside by the exit door.

Outside were I believe more Portland P.D officers, I had the citizens come down to me and then moved them out the exit door.

As they left I could hear the officers outside asking each person as they came out if they saw anything of the suspect(s) or incident, trying to identify any witness(s).

In groups of 4 to 15 we probably moved out about 50 or more civilians that had went into hiding in the stores.

Upon completion of this my team moved to the 2nd floor in front of Macy's to the west of the Food Court.

On the south side I saw the covered body of a male victim; on the north side across the opening to the first floor I saw the body of a white female on her back.

Deputy Joel Manley was there protecting the crime scene, I told him I would take over.

On the floor around the body of the male subject and to the east on the 2nd floor were scattered empty .223 cal. Casings and several magazines.

Det. Bray (CCSO) was on the east side of this 2nd floor scene and identified many casings that he had identified and covered with paper folded into tents.

I looked under several large kiosk booths and found several more which I marked.

Near the body of the male and in a projection pattern to the north and north east were pieces of skull.

I marked these with CCSO Fir Cards that I got from Deputy Miller.

**ACTION
CONTINUED:**

Looking thru the opening down to the first floor where there was a wishing well pond with water visible, I could see more bone fragments.

There were several CCSO Deputies providing security in this area, I dropped down to them more FIR cards and asked them to mark/cover any bone fragments that they could find.

I could see more in the water of the pond, but not much we could do at that point to search the pond area.

It initially appeared that the suspect had shot many times at the male victim on the south side of the 2nd floor by the front of Macy's, striking him in the head at least once killing him.

One or more bullets traveled across the mall 2nd floor and struck the female victim on the north side killing her.

Another PPD officer at my request went outside of the mall and returned with police yellow barrier tape which we put up to protect the crime scenes on the first and second floors.

I remained in this position until about 18:30 Pm when I was relieved by two ATF officers.

I then went to the Command Post by the Transit Center where I met with PPD, Criminalist Finn and Criminalist Martin, and CCSO Sgt. Naccarato (CRAFT)

I was told that PPD would be assisting in the investigation providing their Leica 3D Scanner and personnel to operate it.

The initial plan was for Evidence Technicians to enter the mall, identify evidence, photograph and video tape.

The PPD Leica Unit and the CRAFT team scene would then obtain measurements for diagram purposes.

I left the Town Center, went to the Sheriff Office for CRAFT equipment and returned to the Command Post area.

I stood by with a CRAFT team until about 22:00 hrs. when CCSO Detectives called us into the Mall.

ACTION TAKEN:

At this time PPD had already set up their Leica unit on the 2nd floor by the deceased male and female victims and were scanning.

As it was not necessary to duplicate their efforts there, we then examined the first floor area where the suspect had shot himself.


His body had been moved, fire arm moved, the entire hallway traveled heavily by our Explosive Experts to safeguard this scene, Deputies searching, and investigators.

It was determined that photographs and video of this scene were sufficient and a diagram was not needed.

At about 23:00 hours the CRAFT team was released from the scene.

ACTION TAKEN

On December 11 2012, at about 1555 hours, I was watching television in my home in the Happy Valley area when I saw a news report stating there was an active shooter in the Clackamas Town Center Mall. Outside I could hear emergency vehicle sirens in the distance. I got my handset radio and heard radio transmissions that confirmed there was an active shooter at the mall. I quickly put my uniform on, got in my patrol vehicle and drove to the mall. I arrived at about 1600 hours.

During my drive to the mall I heard reports that multiple shots had been fired in the mall and there were possibly multiple shooters still unaccounted for. I pulled up to the Macy's store entrance on the north side of the mall. I took my AR-15 rifle out of my car and headed into the Macy's store with other law enforcement officers.

Once inside of Macy's, I joined Deputy Bigler, Deputy Nicolai and several other law enforcement personnel. Deputy Nicolai took charge of our group and assigned another officer to be in charge as well. We broke up into two teams and entered the top level of the mall with the intention to search for injured people, people in hiding and any threats or other shooters. Our two groups joined other law enforcement personnel and began clearing the top level of the mall while maintaining communication with those clearing the lower level.

As we went from store to store we found many groups of people that had been hiding in the backs of the stores. The people were escorted out of the stores and outside of the mall. During the clearing process of the top level of the mall, I saw a body lying on the floor near the Macy's store. The body, later identified as Mr. Steven Forsyth, had been covered by a sheet and was surrounded by a large pool of blood. Although I don't recall the exact location, I also saw two AR-15 magazines lying on the floor and several spent casings. When we reached the west end of the mall I was assigned to stand post on upper level of the east end of the mall. I stayed there until released by Sgt. Christensen.

ACTION TAKEN

On Tuesday 12/11/2012 at about 1556 hours Deputy Beyer and I responded to the report of a shooting at the Clackamas Town Center.

Upon arrival we went to the command center and spoke with Capt. Layng. He directed us to go to the location of the downed suspect, later identifies as Jacob Tyler Roberts, and attempt to identify him so we could dispatch personnel to his residence.

Deputy Beyer and I entered the Town Center through the North entrance next to the cinema and into the food court. We went to the Mall Security office and they told us the suspect was in service corridor #2 and gave us directions to the corridor.

We traveled east on the upper main corridor and took the escalators on the east end (next to JC Penny) of the mall to the lower level. The entrance to service corridor #2 was on the north side located between Forever 21 (lower level) and JC Penny.

When we arrived at the corridor we made contact with Deputies O'Keefe and Eason. I told them that we were sent to try and identify the suspect. Prior to touching the suspect I photographed the scene as it was when we arrived.

Deputy O'Keefe and I patted down the exterior of the suspect's pants pockets and couldn't feel any type of wallet or other container that might hold identification.

The suspect was wearing an external load bearing vest so we were unable to check any chest pockets with out significantly disturbing the body. We were unable to readily identify the suspect.

For a short time Deputy Beyer and I assisted directing shoppers and retail employees out the mall by the south lower level door next to Starbucks and Ben & Jerry's.


At approximately 1643 hrs non-uniformed law enforcement were directed out of the mall. Deputy Beyer and I returned to the command post for further/additional assignments.

A decision was made to send families looking for shoppers to the Public Safety Training Center (PSTC) to wait for word on their family members. At about 1705 hour we advised the command post that, if we were not needed at the mall, we would return to PSTC to assist there.

We remained at PSTC until the identities of the victims were established and the family members waiting at PSTC were notified.

NARRATIVE:

On 12/11/12 at approximately 3:35 p.m. I responded to the Clackamas Town Center for an active shooter. Initially I was in a "hunting cell" and searched for the suspect. When the suspect was located, and was dead, I participated in a search for injured people and assisted in evacuating the mall. I then went to the command post and briefed them what I saw and then switched to an investigative role.

After leaving the command post at this time, I went to my vehicle to stow the gear I was wearing in response to the active shooter. Enroute back to the Command Post I encountered Deputy M. Nunn who had information regarding a witness named "Abraham Olvra." Upon arriving at the Command Post I met up with Detectives Wade and Eggleston and asked them to contact and interview this individual, who, according to Deputy Nunn was to be at the Claim Jumper Restaurant in the 8800 block of Sunnyside Road.

At about 6:30 p.m. I met up with members from the Crime Scene Investigation Unit (CSI). Since I had been pre-occupied, they had already met and came up with a plan regarding the crime scene investigation. Oregon State Police would investigate the surroundings of the suspect, CCSO CSI would investigate the location around the victims, and Portland Police would document the scene using a sophisticated imaging machine called "Leica." Initially CSI members were going to enter the

mall to video and photograph. I decided not to accompany them at this time as to not disturb the scene. Instead I went back to the command post. Upon arriving back near the command post I was soon contacted by an unknown Portland Police Commander who told me an individual in the city of Portland suspected the shooter to be an acquaintance, and possible had stolen an AR-15. I assigned this contact to Detectives Wade and Eggleston as they had already completed the previous detail. As it turns out, this lead led to the identification of the shooter.

I was then tasked with finding the suspects vehicle which may be in the CTC parking lot. Command gave me a description of the vehicle and with the assistance of PPB Sergeant Georgioff, I received the assistance of about 14 officers and detectives and I sent them out in search of the vehicle. About 10 minutes later an unknown Portland Officer called me on the phone to advise me he had found the vehicle on the South side of the parking lot near the Macy's store. I had difficulty communicating with the person at the time and he inadvertently left the vehicle, but a State Police Detective was nearby and remained with the vehicle while Command sent explosive ordinance officers and other investigators to inspect, search, and impound the vehicle.

At around this time Sgt. Kollias told me CCSO SWAT would be activated to finish slow clear searching the mall stores so I activated the SWAT team and gave instructions on where to meet up with Sgt. Kollias. As Sgt. Kollias was preparing to coordinate the SWAT activity, he encountered elderly disabled women who was lost at CTC and was trying to get to the MAX line. Since the MAX platform was closed at CTC I drove her to the Fuller Rd. platform. I then returned to the Command Post.

Back at the Command Post I learned some witnesses were coming to this location with information and investigators were needed to speak with them. I contacted Detectives back at the Brooks Station and had some come to the Command Post to handle these requests. I then went into the Crime Scene to check on the status of the Crime Scene Investigation 10:02 p.m.). From this point on I remained a liaison between CCSO, Portland Police, and the Command and lead investigative team regarding the crime scene investigation. I left the crime scene around 4:39 a.m.

I returned to the crime scene around 12:55 p.m. to conduct a final walk-through and evidence search. Detectives Juker and Cate also participated in this search and we found evidence that had not been located before. Specifically we found




indication rounds had been fired through a jewelry store east of the Macy's, and at least one round that was fired from the hall back into Macy's. This evidence was sized and documented by Criminalist Finn and Shelley.

When the final walkthrough was completed I confirmed with Criminalists Finn, Shelley, and Martin that the crime scene investigation was complete. I spoke with Sgt. Anderson around 2:51 p.m. regarding this by telephone and he coordinated the scene security being lifted and the mall being returned to mall management. I communicate this with Trooper D. Swift who was maintaining the log-in checkpoint at the theatre. Around 3:21 Mall Security Captain Garrett arrived and I communicated with him the crime scene hold was being lifted. I obtained the Crime Scene Log from Trooper Swift and later entered it into property. I conducted no further action.

ACTION RECOMMENDED:

Investigation continues.



SUMMARY:

On 12-11-12 at approximately 3:35 p.m., I arrived at the Clackamas Town Center in response to an active shooter. I formed a "hunting cell" with Detective Pat Bray and Deputies J. Manley and J. Campbell. We searched for the suspect through the main Macy's Store and west along the main hall until another cell advised they had located the suspect dead. We then searched for injured victims and assisted in the evacuation of the mall.

ACTION TAKEN:

On 12-11-12 at approximately 3:30 p.m. I was in my office when Detective Fryett told me there was an active shooter at the Clackamas Town Center (CTC). I immediately responded Code 3. My route was west on Sunnybrook Rd, north on SE 84th, then north into CTC from the 8600 block entrance; then proceeded directly to the Macy's main doors. Once there I entered the store and looked for indicators.

Seeing none, I looked back out into the parking lot and saw Deputy Joel Manly. I motioned him inside and soon I saw he was accompanied by Deputy J. Campbell. I told them we would be a hunting cell and would move out in search of the
