

suspect. As we began to move I heard somebody say that they had "rear guard." I looked behind me to see Detective P. Bray fulfilling this function. We moved through Macy's towards the main hallway of the mall.

At this junction I observed two individuals standing inside Macy's seemingly dazed but not injured. I observed one deceased individual in the hallway outside of Macy's and what appeared to be multiple .223 shell casings across the front of the store strewn about on the floor. I saw sporadic people walking around; seeming dazed talking on their cell phone, or just aimlessly looking around. West from this vantage point and on the other side of the hall, I observed another victim down and people tending to her. Besides these two victims and shell casings we saw no other indicators.

Our "hunting cell" made a decision to begin searching west through the hall and as we began to leave the area in front of Macy's, we began to encounter self-evacuating mall patrons. One person saw one of these individuals and said he looked like the shooter. Our group pruned him out, cuffed him, and quickly realized he was not as he did not match the description. He was told to leave the mall with his hands in the air and we continued with our search.

As we continued to move west along the south side of the hall, we heard another cell broadcast the suspect had been located and was dead. We continued in search of injured people that may be hiding. We knocked on store doors asking people if they were O.K. Another group was along the north side of the mall but they got distracted by a locked door so we moved to the north side of the hall and as a group covered the entire hallway and continued to move west. At about this time our group came in contact with Sgt. M. Wold and Deputy J. Brummett and we continued the search with them. I ended up continuing with them downstairs to the lower level and we checked about 1/5<sup>th</sup> of the far west end, lower level, to include some stores, a bathroom, and a service hallway. At about this time I received information from Command that any mall patron's encountered hiding should be escorted out of the mall if they were not a witness; escorted to a staging area if they were a witness.

We then began to go into stores and get the people hiding and walk them to the hallway where other law enforcement officers escorted them outside. I continued to do this until I began to meet up with dozens and dozens of law enforcement officers and now multiple groups were meeting up with each other and the mall seemed saturated with Law Enforcement Officers. I



was then told Command wanted a briefing from somebody who had been in the mall so I went to the Command Post and told them what I saw.

I then switched roles to one of an investigative nature which included coordinating some witness contacts and contact with the owner of the AR-15, release of some exterior stores that had not received word they could go home, a search for the suspect vehicle, and participation in the crime scene investigation.

NARRATIVE:

On 12-11-12 at approximately 3:30 p.m. and while at Brooks Building I learned from Sgt. John Christensen that there was an active shooter incident at the Clackamas Town Center. I responded with numerous other police units from the Brooks Building. While en route I learned that there were victims down and the suspect was described as a white male, wearing a white hockey mask and armed with a rifle and was last seen near the upper level of the Macy's Home Store.

I arrived at approximately 3:35 p.m. and heard the majority of police units were going to make entry into the mall from the JC Penney store. Since the suspect was last seen near the Macy's Home Store I made entry into the mall by way of the Macy's Home Store, which is on the second level to assist in the evacuation of customers and to lock down this exit as a means of escape for the suspect.

As I made entry into the store there were only a few people inside of the store, who I directed to leave the store. Of these customers no one had seen the suspect and I heard no gun shots or any other active shooter activity.

As I walked to the second level mall entrance from the Macy's Home Store I saw a clip to a gun lying on the mall floor and just in front of the Macy's Home Store. I also had contact with Sgt. John Christensen, Deputy John Gibson, and Detective Paul Wade who had made entry into the mall from the service entrance.

Deputy Mark Nikolai and other deputies arrived with us and we cleared the upper level of the Macy's Home Store and did not locate anyone.

During this time we learned that the suspect was down with a self-inflicted gun shot wound in a service corridor near JC Penney's.

I then assisted other deputies with a store by store search for any additional suspects or victims. During our search we located numerous stores that had been in "lock down" and which contained employees and customers. We directed these people out of the mall and to safety.

I was then directed to the command staging location for my next assignment.

Oregon State Police Detective Joe Skipper and I were directed to respond to the Clackamas Town Center Security Office to assist Detective Dan Smith in documenting the businesses that had been cleared by police personnel. During our contacts with the clearing teams we learned that several businesses were locked and could not be cleared.

Also, while at the security office I was asked by Detective Jeff Burlew to review Town Center Security surveillance video and the arrival of a green Jetta, which I learned belonged to the suspect. From reviewing the surveillance video I learned the camera that covers this location

in the parking lot is a panning camera and the actual arrival of the Jetta is not captured on surveillance video. In addition the camera also did not catch the suspect leaving his vehicle and walking into the mall. The surveillance video is able to document the approximate arrival of the Jetta within a few minutes since at around 3:24 p.m. or so there is an empty parking space and then when the camera pans back into this area the Jetta is parked and the suspect is already out of camera view. I asked security to save us a copy of this surveillance video for later retrieval.

During discussions with Lt. Strangefield and the head of mall security they decided that locksmiths would be called to assist in getting into any locked business that needed to be cleared.

At approximately 10:50 p.m. I was involved with Detective Joe Skipper, Detective Dan Smith, Detective John Krummenacker and two SWAT teams, which were directed by Sgt. Tony Kollias and three locksmiths in clearing the remaining locked businesses within the mall. We finished this detail at approximately 2:45 a.m. and did not locate any additional suspects or victims.

I cleared the mall at 2:59 a.m. and went off duty.

After organizing the tips I attempted to contact Kelly Lay by telephone at about 1205 hours. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that he call me.

I returned to GPD at about 1215 hours.

At about 1248 hours Kelly Lay returned my call. Mr. Lay told me that at about 1525 hours he was in front of Taco Time in the food court at Clackamas Town Center. Mr. Lay told me that he heard two "pop, pop's" and then he heard more gun shots. Mr. Lay told me that several rounds went over his head. Mr. Lay told me that he could see rounds hitting the tile above the Taco Time menu board and the ricocheting off. Mr. Lay told me that he saw the shooter out of the corner of his eye. Mr. Lay told me that the shooter was dressed in all black and he saw "flame" coming out of the gun. Mr. Lay told me that, there was "a pause" in the shooting that lasted "maybe a minute or a minute and a half." Mr. Lay told me that he heard "pop, pop" then the pause and then seven or eight shots that went over Mr. Lay's head. Mr. Lay told me that during the pause he ran for the exit doors next to the rest rooms. Mr. Lay told me that it did not seem that the shooter was shooting at anyone in particular. Mr. Lay told me he heard people scream, "He's got a gun." Mr. Lay added that he heard "lots of screaming."

Mr. Lay told me that he was still "shaken up" and that he did not sleep last night. I provided Mr. Lay with the name and phone number of FBI Victim Specialist Caroline Holmes.

At about 1343 hours I attempted to contact Nick Meli by telephone. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that Mr. Meli call me back.

At about 1400 hours I contacted Christina Kissack by telephone. Ms. Kissack told me that at about 1530 hours she, her husband, Stephen Kissack and their daughter, Olivia Kissack were between Cinabon and the escalator on the upper level. Ms. Kissack told me that she heard about "five pop's." Ms. Kissack told me that she thought that something blew up. Ms. Kissack told me that her husband screamed, "It's a gun," and that he then started dragging her backwards. Ms. Kissack told me that she was pulling the stroller with their 20 month old daughter, Olivia, in it. Ms. Kissack told me that she heard between 15 and 20 gun shots. Ms. Kissack told me that she never saw the shooter, but that the gun shots sounded like they were coming from "down below or directly across from us" at Macy's. Ms. Kissack told me that she fell. Ms. Kissack told me that someone picked her up and carried her out. Ms. Kissack told me that Stephen grabbed Olivia and carried her out.

☐ Person After talking to Ms. Kissack she called her husband, Stephen Kissack, to the phone and I interviewed him. Mr. Kissack told me that at about 1529 hours he "heard a big bang." Mr. Kissack told me that he knew it was a gun, because he grew up around guns. Mr. Kissack told me that he "looked around and saw him in front of Macy's walking their way." Mr. Kissack told me that he, Christina and Olivia were in front of Cinabon when the shooting started. Mr. Kissack told me that the shooter shot at Taco Time first and then "he turned around and shot towards Sears." Mr. Kissack told me that the shooter's gun then jammed, so Mr. Kissack "grabbed" Christina and tugged her backwards. Mr. Kissack told me that Christina fell on her stomach and that he picked up Olivia. Mr. Kissack told me that "some guy" picked up Christina and they ran to the exit doors by the movie theatre's. Mr. Kissack told me that when Christina fell, her black glasses came off and that they are probably still laying on the floor in front of Cinabon.

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gun was a black assault rifle and that it was "really loud." Mr. Kissack told me that the shooter was about 5'6" to 5'7" tall and about 150 pounds.

Mr. Kissack told me that when they got to their car he drove Christina to her OB/GYN, because Christina is 13 weeks pregnant and she had fallen on her stomach. Mr. Kissack told me that Christina and the baby are not injured. Mr. Kissack told me that he was shaken up, that he went to the ER and that he called his psychologist. Mr. Kissack told me that the ER doctor gave him Adovan, so that he could sleep. I provided Mr. Kissack with the name and phone number of FBI Victim Specialist Caroline Holmes.

At about 1446 hours I attempted to contact Kylie by telephone, but it answered to voice mail. I left a message requesting that Kylie call me back.

At about 1501 hours I contacted Jill Howard by telephone. Ms. Howard told me that she is a "Fragrance Freelance Worker" and that on 121112 she was working at the Macy's store at Clackamas Town Center. Ms. Howard told me that she "was working at tables set up at the very front of Macy's at the entrance to the mall." Ms. Howard told me that she is not sure of the time, but that she was at the "far right" of the tables looking into the mall when she heard two gun shots. Ms. Howard told me that she looked over and saw the shooter, not far from her, on the upper level, between the entrance to Macy's and the railing. Ms. Howard told me that when she saw the shooter, the gun "looked like it was pointing up, not down at people." Ms. Howard told me that she heard a total of between 10 and 20 gun shots. Ms. Howard told me that she heard "pow, pow" and that the shooter then lowered the gun and she heard "pow, pow, pow,..." Ms. Howard told me that she got down on the floor and that the gun shots sounded like they "were going away" from her. Ms. Howard told me that she took shelter in a Macy's stock room and that she left the store after she heard a P.A. announcement to evacuate the store. Ms. Howard told me that she went through Macy's to the outside.

I asked Ms. Howard if she could describe the shooter and she told me that the shooter was wearing a mask and dark clothes. Ms. Howard told me that the gun was "big, very long and very loud." Ms. Howard told me that the gun was dark colored.

Ms. Howard told me that the shooter "started shooting right outside Macy's." Ms. Howard told me that the shooter was "running to the right." Ms. Howard told me that the shooter was "running forward, but not in a straight line."

At about 1530 hours I attempted to contact Britney Harter by telephone. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that she call me.

At about 1532 hours I contacted Sheila Borgman by telephone. I asked Ms. Borgman about her call on 121112 reporting an incident at her apartment complex, Heather Brae Commons. Ms. Borgman told me that at about 1720 hours her daughter, Abby Borgman, received a telephone call from her friend, Cheyenne (unknown last name). Ms. Borgman told me that Cheyenne told Abby that Kerry Elliott had just run into her house and said that he needed a place to hide from the police. Ms. Borgman told me that Cheyenne told Abby that Kerry had told her that he had arranged the shooting at the Clackamas Town Center, so that the police would all be busy and he could run away with his girlfriend, Juana Hernandez [REDACTED] Ms. Borgman told me that Kerry is 17 YOA and that Kerry's mother has kicked him out of the house. Ms. Borgman told me that Kerry has nowhere to live. Ms. Borgman told me that Cheyenne told Abby that Kerry showed her a check for \$2000. Ms. Borgman told me that deputies came to Heather Brae Commons last night and arrested Kerry for telling people that he had planned the shooting at Clackamas Town Center.

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At about 1622 hours I attempted to contact Joseph Galvan by telephone. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that he call me.

At about 1630 hours I attempted to contact Jared Ryan Maldonado by telephone. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that he call me.

At about 1709 hours I received a telephone call from Jared Ryan Maldonado. Mr. Ryan Maldonado told me that at about 1510 hours on 121112 he saw a WMJ come out of the rest room on the lower level of the Clackamas Town Center, near J.C. Penny. Mr. Ryan Maldonado told me that the subject was 18 to 20 YOA with brown hair in a pony tail, a red back pack and wearing "cammo" clothing. Mr. Ryan Maldonado told me that the subject "gave me a weird vibe" so he called in the tip after he heard about the shooting. Mr. Ryan Maldonado told me that he saw a photo of the shooter on-line today and that the shooter is not the same person that he saw leaving the rest rooms on 121112. Mr. Ryan Maldonado told me that he did not see the shooter at Clackamas Town Center on 121112.

At about 1803 hours I received a voice mail message, dated 121212 at 1803 hours, from Nick Meli. I tried to return his call at about 1821 hours, but evidently got a bad connection as I could hear him, but he could not hear me. I called Mr. Meli again at 1823 hours and left another voice mail message requesting that he call me to arrange a time to meet for an interview.

At about 1825 hours Mr. Meli returned my telephone call and he requested to meet with me for the interview at GPD. Mr. Meli agreed to come to GPD on 121312 between 0930 hours and 1000 hours for an interview.

On 121312 at about 0730 hours I discovered a black sweatshirt in my detective vehicle with blood on it. I noted that it had been cut, as if cut off of someone. I realized that this sweatshirt must have been cut off of Kristina Shevchenko by medical personnel at Clackamas Town Center on 121112 and left in my car. I seized the sweatshirt as evidence and completed a PIC for it.

At about 0758 hours I attempted to contact Kylie by telephone, but it answered to voice mail. I left a message requesting that Kylie call me back.

At about 0800 hours I contacted Britney Harter by telephone. Ms. Harter told me that sometime between about 1530 hours and 1545 hours on 121112 she was exiting Clackamas Town Center through the doors between Panda Express and the movie theatre's. Ms. Harter told me that she saw a guy outside, walking into the mall wearing a white plastic face mask and a black trench coat. Ms. Harter told me that the subjects black or dark brown hair was pulled back into a short pony tail. Ms. Harter told me that the subject did not say anything to her, that he was not carrying anything and that his hands were in his pockets. Ms. Harter told me that she told the subject that he should take off the mask, because "it's kind of scary." Ms. Harter told me that the mask covered the subjects face from his eyebrows down, that it had eye holes and "little slits in it." Ms. Harter told me that it was "kind of like a hockey mask." Ms. Harter told me that as she was driving home she saw the police cars responding.

At about 0919 hours I attempted to contact Joseph Galvan by telephone. The call answered to voice mail and I left a message requesting that he call me.

At about 0927 hours Nicolas Meli arrived at GPD for an interview. I recorded the interview and advised Mr. Meli that the interview was being recorded. Mr. Meli told me that he was outside of Macy's, by Morgan Jeweler's on 121112 when he three heard gunshots. Mr. Meli told me that he was with his girlfriend, Casey

**VOSS:** So, Nic if you don't mind, I'm gonna go ahead and record this so I get everything right.

**MELI:** Right.

**VOSS:** Um, you don't have any problems with that?

**MELI:** No.

**VOSS:** Ok, the times 9:28, Detective Voss, I'm here with Nicolas Meli..Meeli?

**MELI:** Meli. (*pronounced Mee-lie*)

**VOSS:** Meli. Um..

**MELI:** There's no 'H' in my name. N-I-C-O-L-A-S.

**VOSS:** M-E-L-I?

**MELI:** Yes.

**VOSS:** N-I-C-O-L-A-S?

**MELI:** Yeah. No 'H.'

**VOSS:** Ok, thanks for..so, let's start from the top. About what time and what did you see and where?

**MELI:** Um, I was out front of Macy's Home, upper level by Morgan Jewelers. And, uh, at that time I heard 3 shots and I turned and looked and I asked, uh, Casey, I was like 'Are you serious?' And, I handed the baby off and then I heard about 8 more rapid fire shots and uh, I peered around the corner and I saw a man wearing a uh, white 'Jason' ski mask and a black sweater and black pants with a uh, AR-15 assault rifle.

**MELI:** He came running towards where I was. And I took cover behind uh, the pillar. The main structure pillar. Not like right up against it but kind of out. Cause, uh, I wasn't sure where he was going from there. And then I noticed that he stopped and he was...'cause his rifle had malfunctioned. And he was pulling the charging handle.

**MELI:** And that's when I stepped out and I drew my weapon. And, uh, I placed it on his head and I got tunnel vision from there. And, uh, as I was going to pull, I saw someone in the background move, uh, inside that Charlotte Russe store, so I knew that if I was to shoot and I was to miss, I could end up injuring someone from inside there. So, I decided not to and that's when I think he got his rifle cleared 'cause he turned and he looked at me and I started backing up to inside of Macy's Home. And, uh, as I was doing that, uh, I was telling the people to run. To get out of there. And then I think I may have reached the escalator inside of Macy's and that's when I turned..it like popped in my head like, I was like 'oh my god, they're gonna think that I left them.' So I doubled back through the store, um, and, uh, I saw a magazine laying on the ground.

**VOSS:** Ok.

**MELI:** I don't know where he went from there. But I went and took a position inside of the Morgan Jewelers to protect my friends and family that I had hide inside of that store. And then I was handed a phone and talked to the 911 dispatcher about what happened. And, I just waited there and then Schoenfeld and other deputies showed up and gave them all the information that I had for..

**VOSS:** Ok. Has anybody else interviewed you?

**MELI:** Yeah. I was interviewed by Detective Patrick Bryan...Bray.

**VOSS:** Bray?

**MELI:** Yeah.

**VOSS:** Ok. And when did he interview you?

**MELI:** Yesterday.

**VOSS:** Oh, ok, alright. I didn't..I wasn't aware of that. Um,

**MELI:** No, I do security. But I have..

**MELI:** ..a concealed weapons permit and I always carry wherever I..

**VOSS:** Alright, good enough. Nic thanks for coming in, thanks for taking the time to come in and I'm going to go ahead and terminate the tape at this point.

I entered the property from SE Sunnyside Rd and was proceeding to the north side of the property when I saw Lt Strangefield near the parking structure on the east side of the property near I205. I asked him where I was needed. He advised me to park inside the parking structure. I parked my patrol car just inside the structure. I deployed my department issued shotgun.

I met an unknown transit officer in plain clothes displaying a badge and carrying a rifle. At the time CCOM was advising that the active shooter was reportedly inside the Macys Home store.

The transit officer and I made our way towards the Macys Home store. We met up with West Linn Detective Sgt. Tonkin near the NE corner of Macys Home. Sgt. Tonkin was wearing a full camo swatt uniform with a helmet that had a vision device. He was also carrying a rifle.

The three of us made our way to the North exterior entrance/exit to the Macy Home store. We listen and watched for active shooter indicators with negative results. An unknown Deputy inside the building advised that they had the interior portion of the Macys Home store covered and needed the exterior entrance/ exit covered. The unit also requested a dog. I advised that the exterior entrance/exit was covered. This was my first radio transmission during the incident.

After an unknown period of time a unit inside the building advised that the shooter had been located and was 12-44. Deputy Nikolai arrived.

Deputy Nikolai, Sgt. Tonkin, the transit officer and I entered the North entrance/exit doors to Macys Home. Clackamas Fire personnel were behind us as we moved through the store looking for wounded victims or other suspects. We found none.

Once we arrived at the interior entrance/exit I smelled a strong smell of some burning. I thought that it was more than likely burned food from the food court.

We made our way towards the west searching for citizens or suspects. We encountered locked doors or security gates on some of the businesses. We cleared businesses that weren't locked down.

There were many Deputies and officers inside the mall by this time doing the same thing. At some point Deputy Nashif joined us.

As we approached the regular Macys store on the second level I saw a 12-44 subject who was prone on the floor and covered by a blue sheet. There was a large pool of blood on the floor near the subjects head.

We cleared Macys with members of the Portland Police. We didn't find anybody inside. As we exited I saw that Deputy Bailey was starting to process the crime scene near the 12-44 subject.

I made my way back towards Macys Home with Deputy Nikolai and Deputy Nashif and members of the Portland Police. Deputy Nikolai and I walked to the area of Barnes and Noble and the second floor. We maintained a position there. A group of about 10 people who had been locked down inside the Hollister store were escorted to our location by a Deputy.

I walked two of the people who said they were witnesses to the command post and turned them over to a Transit officer. He advised he would walk them to the detectives who were set up at the Transit Police platform office. At this point the time was about 1815 hrs.

I cleared the scene about 1830 hrs.

### NARRATIVE

On 12-10-11 while working in the courthouse, I heard CCOM dispatch an active shooter at the town center. Per Lt. Brandenburg's orders, Deputy Kauffman and I each responded. I arrived at the town Center lower level outside REI and Macy's where I met up with Deputy Rippe and several other deputies. Once we had a team of 5 we entered and headed towards the lower mall entrance of the Macy's Home store.

The only thing I noticed out of the ordinary (less the lack of people) was a pair of shoes in the walkway outside the Orange Julius stand. We held at the entrance to Macy's for a short time. Several more officers arrived at the

entrance. I held at the door covering the west side of the Macy's store while the rest of the team began searching the lower level of Macy's in a counterclockwise pattern.

As more officers arrived, I joined up with a team from West Linn and began searching the stairwells on the east side of the building. I heard on the radio that the body of one shooter had been located. After we cleared the stairwells, we returned to the lower mall entrance. I escorted two employees out of the Orange Julius to waiting deputies at the entrance to the mall near REI.

I joined up with Sgt. Anderson and several other deputies and began searching stores and back hallways. We searched from the mall entrance (lower south side near REI and Macy's) west to, and including, the lower level of the Macy's store. As we finished command ordered uniformed officers to take positions inside the mall.

As I was heading from the Macy's store back towards the Mall entrance I noticed there was broken glass on the floor. I looked up and noticed the glass part of the railing on the upper level was broken. I saw that deputy Campbell had marked some type of evidence in the courtyard outside Macy's.

I covered the courtyard area outside the lower entrance of the Macy's home store with Deputy Toops. An employee at the Avon store peeked out from the back room and said that there was a customer in her store along with a small child. I escorted them to waiting deputies at the entrance near REI. Deputy Toops and I heard that there were people inside stores near the build-a-bear which was just west of our location. We responded and escorted them out of the building through the village entrance. As we were walking back towards Macy's Home Store I was alerted to people inside the Abercrombie and Fitch store. Deputy Toops and I again escorted them to deputies at the village entrance.

I remained near the Abercrombie and Fitch store until the OSP Swat worked up towards my position. I then moved East to the Macy's Home store until Swat worked up to my location. I cleared the interior of the mall and reported to the command post. After rehab, I responded to the south upper level doors to Macy's and relieved Trooper Ferguson. I maintained security of the entry until the doors were locked by detectives. Sgt. Thoroughman had me do perimeter security on the south side of the mall. I was relieved by Deputy L. Jones and cleared the scene at 0025 hrs.

None Obtained – Everyone I contacted stated that they heard the gunshots but did not actually see the shooting.

I contacted Jessica and she told me she is an acquaintance of Jacob's and has known him a couple of weeks. She said she saw Jacob last Friday night (12/7/12) at The Space Room, a bar across from his workplace. She said Jacob was acting strange. Jessica said Jacob was leaving for Hawaii sometime over the weekend. Jessica said that instead of appearing happy and excited, he had a "blank" face and seemed "numb". Jessica said she thought Jacob had received an inheritance of approximately \$10,000 - \$15,000. Jessica said after Jacob left the bar that Friday evening, she did not know anyone who had contacted him.

Jessica said she did not know if Jacob actually had a plane ticket to Hawaii.



She told me that she has never seen Jacob with weapons and he has never talked to her about weapons. She hesitated when I asked her about his drug use and said she couldn't say anything for sure.

Jessica said she did not know that Jacob was planning on doing this and did not know of any friends that had any idea he was going to murder anyone.

Jessica was hesitant to provide me information and details throughout our contact. She told me she did not want anyone to know that she was providing this information. I assured her I was not releasing her name or phone number to the media. I told her I would write this report up and place it in the case file.



NARRATIVE:

On 12/12/12 at approximately 1230 hours I was asked by Sgt. Anderson to contact Thomas (Tom) Stewart. Thomas had called into dispatch and told them he was the owner of the property Jacob Roberts' was living at.

I called Tom back and he told me he was just calling in because he hadn't been contacted yet and he owned the residence located at [REDACTED] Portland, Oregon 97266.

I asked Tom what he knew about Jacob Roberts. Tom told me Jacob was a friend of the people actually on the lease for the residence, Chris Dahrens and Jamie Eheler. Tom said he thought Jacob was a friend of Jamie's brother. He did not know Jamie's brother's name.

I asked Tom how Jacob came to live in the residence. He told me in late August, Chris and Jamie moved into [REDACTED] Tom told me around that time, they asked if they could have Jacob live in the basement of the residence. Tom said he needed to meet Jacob first.

Tom told me he met Jacob in late August. Tom described Jacob as courteous and polite. He said they all had a 10 minute conversation the back steps of the house about Jacob moving into the basement. Tom said he authorized Jacob to move into the basement, but he would still be collecting the rent only from Chris and Jamie, who were on the lease.

Tom said he has done repairs on the home 4-5 times since Jacob moved in, none of which were in Jacob's room. He told me he didn't notice anything unusual during that time.

Tom told me approximately 1 ½ weeks ago, Chris told him Jacob came across some money, possibly from an investment or inheritance, and was planning on moving to Hawaii.

Tom told me Chris had a medical marijuana card and he had seen a bong at the residence. Tom told me he wasn't aware of and had never seen any weapons in the house.

Tom said he didn't know Jacob's phone number, but he knew he drove a green VW Jetta.

Tom told he was available for contact if any further information was necessary.





#### **NARRATIVE:**

On 12-11-2012 at about 3:30pm I was working in my cubicle at the Brooks building when I heard Deputy Kishpaugh state there was an active shooter at the Clackamas Town Center. I left my cubicle and told Sergeant Kollias there was an active shooter as I exited the building to my car.

I drove to the East end of the mall and parked at the North doors to JC Penny where I put on my SWAT heavy vest. As Deputy Kishpaugh and I were entering the store we were joined by Sgt. Kollias, Detective Cate.

We entered the JC Penny on the upper floor through the northeast doors and contacted an employee inside. The male employee was certain Mr. Roberts did not get into their store. He said they closed and locked all of the doors. The employee went with us to the large roll up door to the second floor of the mall which he opened. At about 3:40pm we entered the central common area of the mall and began quickly moving forward listening for signs of where Mr. Roberts was. We came to a set of doors to the employee corridors prior to reaching Macy's Home store. We now had Deputy Eason, Deputy O'Keeffe and two OSP Troopers with us.

We entered the corridor as a large cell and cleared to a set of stairs where we all went down to the first floor. At this intersection I went right with Detective Cate, Deputy O'Keeffe, Deputy Eason and one OSP Officer into corridor 2. We made our way to the last section of the corridor which would have brought us back into the lower level of the common area of the mall right in front of JC Penny.

As we rounded the corner into this last section I saw a male on the floor near the doors to the common area. There was an assault rifle on the floor next to the male as well as a puddle of blood. We slowly made our way to the male while commands were given. Once I was closer I could see a large hole in the top of Mr. Roberts' head. At this time it was evident that he was deceased. I also saw a white mask on the floor in front of his body.

At about 3:51pm I got on the radio to advise command and dispatch that we located a male that appeared to be the shooting suspect. I broadcast the male was deceased and that he had an assault rifle and white mask. Captain Layng, Incident Commander, requested that two people remain with Mr. Robert's body while the rest



of us continued to check for other suspects and injured people. Deputies Eason and O'Keeffe remained with the body.

The OSP Trooper, Detective Cate and I carefully walked around the body so we did not disturb any evidence as we exited the corridor into the common area of the mall. At this point we waited briefly until we were joined by Lieutenant Smith and other officers from various agencies. As we were making a plan to fan out we learned Sgt. Coleman was working toward us with another hunting cell. We waited for them to join us and then split into four smaller teams.

We planned to have the four teams split up with two teams on the lower floor, one going down each side, and two on the upper floor doing the same thing as we pushed forward together. I went upstairs with officers from various agencies and pushed forward on the right, North, side of the upper level. As we pushed forward I yelled into businesses that were secured making sure there were no injuries and telling the citizens to remain inside until another team came to get them out.

After moving forward for a short time we came to another cell of officers that were on the South side of the upper level. Deputies Nikolai and Bigler were in this cell with other officers. As we moved further ahead I heard officers behind us getting employees and customers out of stores and getting them out of the mall.

Once we arrived at the food court area I saw officers ahead of us to the West. I also saw what I later learned was Mr. Forsyth's body under a blue blanket on the South side of the upper level in front of Macy's. I helped clear several of the food restaurants in the food court.

At about 4:43pm I heard Captain Layng ask that any non-uniformed personnel exit the mall while uniformed personnel set up in strong points. I exited the mall and went to the Command Post that was stationed near the Tri Met parking garage at the East end of the Town Center.

After a few minutes I was called into the Command Post and asked where Mr. Roberts' body was located. I described the location and was told there were reports of another victim outside of Gentle Dental. I went back into the mall with Sgt. Kollias, Detective Cate and Deputy Kishpaugh. Once we arrived at Gentle Dental, which was on the lower level next to JC Penny and corridor 2. We confirmed that this was Mr. Roberts' body only and there were no other victims in this area. We exited the mall and returned to the Command Post area.

While I was at the Command Post I was contacted by Lieutenant Babst who asked me to take the Crime Scene Investigators to Mr. Roberts' body when they were ready. I waited at the Command Post until we were told we could re-enter the mall.

At about 6:34pm I re-entered the mall through the main mall doors next to the theatres which led to the food court. Deputy Lister was at this door and was starting a crime scene log. After I was logged in I entered the door and waited for Detective Lee, Detective Cate, Detective Nunn, Crime Scene Investigators Finn and Shelly as



well as other Crime Scene Investigators for the Portland Police Bureau and Oregon State Police Forensics Lab.

At this time several SWAT teams were doing a thorough clearing of the mall, but they were still working on the West side of the building. There was still confusion on how many shooters were involved so I remained in my heavy vest and was with the group for security reasons while they video recorded the scenes.

I followed my group, Crystal Bell with the Oregon State Police Forensic Lab, Detective Lee and another Crime Scene Investigator toward Mr. Roberts' body. After the scene was recorded we exited the mall and I returned to my vehicle and took off my vest.

I returned to the Command Post where I was contacted by Sgt. Boell and assigned to contact Ms. Yuille's family about her death, see separate report for details.


I returned to the Brooks building and learned we identified Mr. Roberts as the shooter and that a search warrant was being prepared for his residence. Detectives Erichsen and Shipley were preparing to go to Mr. Roberts' residence to interview his roommates, Chris Dahrens and Jamie Eheler. Detective Bray and I drove in our vehicles to the residence and waited outside to relieve Detectives Erichsen and Shipley if needed while waiting for the search warrant.

At about 10:33pm Detective Erichsen came outside and asked me and Detective Bray to come inside and relieve him and Detective Shipley. We went into the residence where we were introduced to Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler. Detectives Erichsen and Shipley left the residence.

We waited in the residence with Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler until other detectives arrived with the search warrant, see separate report for details.

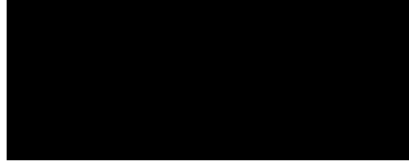

**NARRATIVE:**

On 12-11-2012 while at the Command Post I was contacted by Sgt. Boell and assigned to contact Ms. Yuille's family about her death. Sgt. Boell gave me a piece of paper listing the victim as Christine Lynn Yuille with an address of [REDACTED] Avenue in Portland.

I joined Deputy Medical Examiner (DME) Cathy Phelps and Victim's Advocate Carrie Walker who were going to assist with the notification. We left the command post at about 7:46pm and drove to the location together in my vehicle.

We arrived at the residence at about 8:01pm and contacted a male at the door who identified himself as Robert Yuille. DME Phelps identified us and Mr. Yuille asked what was going on. DME Phelps repeated that she was a Deputy Medical Examiner and Mr. Yuille started crying and stated he knew something was wrong. DME Phelps explained that we responded to the Clackamas Town Center and that Ms. Yuille was killed during the shooting.

Mr. Yuille was emotional and started to raise his voice and mentioned that he called to see if Ms. Yuille was one of the victims and was told all of the notifications were already made. We asked if anybody else was home and he said his teenage son, Hunter, was.

We went inside with Mr. Yuille where we tried to console him and give him the limited information that we had. While inside Mr. Yuille talked about his wife Cindy. DME Phelps asked Mr. Yuille if his wife was Christine and he stated that was his ex-wife's name. At this time I was not sure what information I received was correct. I asked Mr. Yuille for Cindy's birth date which matched what I had.

I stepped outside and called DME Tonsfeldt and confirmed the deceased was Cindy Yuille. I went back inside and told them it was Cindy that was deceased. We talked with Mr. Yuille for a few minutes and asked if there was anybody we could contact and he asked that we contact Ms. Yuille's daughter, Jenna, for him. He did not have her address so I called Detective Shipley to see if we could find a current address to make personal contact.


While we were waiting for Detective Shipley to get back to me Jenna called the house and Mr. Yuille broke down on the phone and told her what happened. I talked briefly with Jenna and told her Ms. Yuille was shot while at the Clackamas Town Center and was deceased. Jenna said she would be coming to Mr. Yuille's and that she had somebody to drive her. I told her Mr. Yuille had our business cards if she needed to contact either of us.



We cleared the residence.

**NARRATIVE:**

On 12-11-2012 at about 10:33pm Detective Erichsen exited the residence at [REDACTED] Portland where he and Detective Shipley were interviewing the residents, Chris Dahrens and Jamie Eheler. Detective Erichsen told me they completed the interviews and had information to provide to Detective Copenhaver who was in the process of writing the search warrant affidavit at the Brooks building.

Detective Bray and I entered the house where we were introduced to Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler. They were both cooperative and invited us to have a seat in the gathering room. Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler were aware of our office applying for a search warrant. Detectives Erichsen and Shipley cleared the residence.

While waiting for the search warrant we made small talk in the living room. During this time Mr. Dahrens told us he saw the shooting on the news and became suspicious of his roommate, Jacob Roberts. He said he did not observe any signs from Mr. Roberts, but thought the description of the shooter sounded like Mr. Roberts.

Mr. Dahrens said he went downstairs to Mr. Roberts room and looked around. He said he found packages for 30 round AR magazines as well as receipts and empty ammunition boxes. He said he left the room and did not know what to do. He said as the day progressed he talked to some other people about what he saw and they suggested he call the police.

Mr. Dahrens said he went to Mr. Roberts room again to double check and saw more magazine packages and targets as well as a small clear zip lock bag with a white substance inside. Mr. Dahrens said he opened the bag and smelled it and said it smelled like methamphetamine. Mr. Dahrens told me he had a methamphetamine habit a few years ago and knows what methamphetamine smells like. Mr. Dahrens told me the packages and receipts were on the floor next to the bed.

I asked Mr. Dahrens if he was aware that Mr. Roberts was using methamphetamine and he said he was not. He said he did not see any signs that Mr. Roberts was using drugs.



Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler told me Mr. Roberts was selling off his belongings and was supposed to fly to Hawaii, where he was planning to live, on December 8<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Eheler told me Mr. Roberts did not leave on his flight. Mr. Dahrens told me Mr. Roberts vehicle, a green 1996 Jetta, was listed for sale on Craigslist. Mr. Dahrens pulled up the posting on his laptop and asked if I wanted a printed copy of the ad, I said I did. At about 12:19am Mr. Dahrens printed the ad which I have attached to this report for details.

At about 12:57am Sgt. Anderson called me and said the search warrants were issued and detectives were enroute to the residence.

At about 1:04am detectives began arriving at the residence. We waited until about 1:16am when Detective Eggleston read the search warrant to Mr. Dahrens and Ms. Eheler. Detective Nunn took photographs of the residence prior to the search.

I went downstairs to Mr. Roberts bedroom area and began searching from the stairway and worked my way to a table that was to the left of the bed mattress. I saw a glass water pipe on the top of the table which is commonly used to smoke marijuana based on my training and experience, PIC #14. I also found a piece of paper with handwritten notes that appeared to be Mr. Roberts flight plans to leave for Hawaii, PIC #15.

Next I searched a plastic shopping bag that was on the floor between the table and the mattress. In this bag I located the following items: a new package of "Shoot-n-c" targets, PIC #10; four empty boxes of American Eagle .223 ammunition, PIC #11; two plastic Pro Mag packages for 30 round AR magazines, PIC # 12; two plastic bag packages for 30 round P-Mag AR magazines, PIC #13; a label for gloves and a "Duck Tape" brand plastic package, PIC #16; receipts from Walmart, The Gun Broker and Wholesale Sports dated 12-08-12 and 12-09-12 for magazines, ammunition, targets and earplugs, PIC #17; a paper bag with "The Gun Broker" stamped on it, PIC #18; and a small clear zip lock bag with a white powder substance, PIC #19.

I put the above listed items into separate bags and took them upstairs to the kitchen table where Detective Burlew was completing the Property in Custody (PIC) reports. I labeled each bag as Detective Burlew logged it on the PIC.

I did not search any other rooms or seize any other evidence. At about 1:58am the search was completed and I exited the residence. I put myself enroute to the Brooks building to meet with Detective Pearson to put the seized items into a secure locker. We arrived at about 2:04am and I carried some of the evidence into the secure evidence room of the Brooks building. We placed all of the seized items into locker #57 and I removed the key and secured it in my cubicle drawer.

I cleared for the night.

On 12-12-2012 at about 10:00am I returned to work and attended a briefing on the shooting. At this time I told the other investigators that I seized several receipts from the search warrant. Sgt. Anderson assigned Detectives Pearson and Erichsen to contact these stores regarding the purchases. At about 11:30am I opened locker





#57 and removed the paper bag containing the receipts. I took the bag to the investigations area on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor and photocopied the receipts. I placed the original receipts back in the bag and stapled the top. I gave a copy of the receipts to Detective Pearson. I have attached a copy of the receipts to this report for details.

Later I gave the bag containing the receipts and the locker key to Detective Burlew.

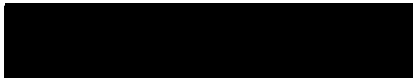

## NARRATIVE:

On 12/11/12 at approximately 1530 hours I was at the CCSO Brooks Building and was alerted there was an active shooter incident at the Clackamas Town Center (CTC). I immediately went downstairs and saw Det. Copenhaver preparing to leave. I grabbed my exterior vest and rode with him to the CTC.

During the drive to the CTC, which took approximately 60 seconds, I heard reports over the radio that the suspect was wearing body armor and had an assault rifle. His current location was unknown.

I heard over the radio several calls of police officers had entered the mall and were attempting to locate the suspect. At the time Det. Copenhaver and I arrived at a southeastern entrance to the mall by the restaurant Claim Jumper, there was no active shooting occurring. We were asked to use Det. Copenhaver's vehicle to block an access road off SE Sunnyside Road so that no civilians could come into the mall, and Det. Copenhaver did so.

Det. Copenhaver and I then advanced towards the mall on foot. We made contact with Capt. Layng at the command post near the Trimet Green Line stop, who directed

us to go to the CTC security office on the northern side of the mall and provide a coordination point between the command post and CTC security and video. Det. Copenhaver and I went to the office by the food court entrance on the north side. We passed many officers holding positions on CTC exit points. We got to the doors which accessed the CTC security office. There was no one around and I saw an exterior door was propped open. Det. Copenhaver and I went inside and cleared a hallway to the CTC office. We were let inside and began monitoring the video surveillance system for the suspect(s) to assist the officers actively clearing the mall.

After the mall was initially cleared, I looked at historical CTC footage from the time of the shooting. I saw a man who I thought might be related entering the food court entrance of the mall just prior to the shooting. I took photos and video of this footage and messaged the photos to Lt. Strangfield using Det. Copenhaver's phone.

Lt. Strangfield assigned Det. Copenhaver and I to keep track of what stores in the mall were cleared by police. Det. Copenhaver left several minutes later. I received updates from various police officers via the radio that certain stores had been cleared and not cleared. Stores that were locked were labeled as not cleared on the map.

CCSO Detective Millett and OSP Detective Skipper arrived to assist me. As we received updates on cleared and not cleared stores we marked them on a map.

After the initial hasty clearance of the mall, it was determined a more deliberate and thorough clearance of each and every store in the mall was appropriate to make sure no people were left behind.

Many stores in the mall were locked. We requested a master key to the stores from CTC security and was told each store was individually locked and CTC security did not have keys to each store.

The two options to clear each store were 1) request each individual store owner return to a staging area and provide a key to access their locked store or 2) use a locksmith to access each store.

It was decided we would use the services of a locksmith to access each locked store.

Locksmiths were requested and two arrived.

The CCSO tactical team was assembled and broken up into two contingents. Detective Krummenacker and I were assigned to the team on the lower level with a locksmith. Detectives Millett and Skipper were assigned to the team on the upper level with a locksmith.

The lower team started performing a thorough clearance of stores on the lower level at approximately 1050 hours. This clearance was focused on locked businesses. We attempted to enter businesses that were locked and were not confirmed as cleared.



I kept track of the businesses that were cleared to make sure each and every business was cleared on the lower level. I did not specifically mark each business that the locksmith worked on.

All businesses on the lower level except Helzberg Diamonds and Just Sports were cleared. The locks on these businesses were unable to be breached by the locksmith.

The lower level was cleared at 0251 hours on 12/12/12.

I was given keys to the Nordstrom store when I was sitting in the CTC security office. I returned these keys to Heather at the CTC security office.

I left the premises at approximately 0259 hours.

This completed my investigation for the day.

On 12/13/12 I placed the maps we used into evidence.

On 12-13-2012 I was assigned to follow up on tip #726-127 that was left on 12-12-2012 by James Ferrell.

At about 1:02pm I called the phone number listed on the tip report and talked to Janis Ferrell. Ms. Ferrell told me Mr. Ferrell was currently at work.

Ms. Ferrell told me she and Mr. Ferrell were at the Clackamas Town Center when the shooting occurred. She said they just came out of the Made In Oregon store and were walking toward Best Buy when she heard gun shots and saw glass breaking in front of them on the Best Buy store. Ms. Ferrell said she is familiar with guns and immediately knew they were gunshots. She said she told Mr. Ferrell they were gunshots and he threw her to the ground and covered her with his body.

Ms. Ferrell did not see the shooter or anything else, she only heard the shots. Ms. Ferrell told me Mr. Ferrell saw Cindy Yuille go down. Ms. Ferrell gave me Mr. Ferrell's cell and work phone numbers. Ms. Ferrell told me Mr. Ferrell was having a difficult time now and blamed himself for not helping Ms. Yuille more. I gave her the phone number to the Clackamas County Crisis line and told her they were providing assistance to witnesses of the shooting.

At about 1:14pm I called Mr. Ferrell's cell phone and the call went straight to voicemail. I then called his work phone number which he answered.

Mr. Ferrell told me he and Ms. Ferrell left the Made in Oregon Store and were walking toward the Best Buy store. Mr. Ferrell said he heard what he later realized was a gunshot and saw the glass straight ahead of them at the Best Buy shatter. He said he heard a second shot and saw Cindy Yuille fall to the ground. Mr. Ferrell said Ms. Ferrell stated those were gunshots so he threw Ms. Ferrell to the ground and covered her with his body.

Mr. Ferrell told me he heard a third shot and saw glass at the center of the mall railing near them break. Mr. Ferrell said there was a short silence and then he heard about three more shots. Mr. Ferrell assumed the shooter changed directions as the sound coming from the gun was different. He said there was another short pause and then about four more shots.

Mr. Ferrell believes the shooter was shooting at him and his wife based on the glass breaking around them.

Mr. Ferrell said after the shooting stopped he looked over toward Ms. Yuille and saw her on her knees in what he described looked like a Yoga position. Mr. Ferrell said he turned to his wife and asked if she was okay and then looked back to Ms. Yuille to see her now face down on the ground.

Mr. Ferrell said he ran over to Ms. Yuille and put his hand on her shoulder telling her to stay still and that help would be coming. He said he initially felt Ms. Yuille moving, but saw her skin turn grayish. He said she quit moving and he noticed she urinated and he knew she was dead.

Mr. Ferrell said a male ran up to him and was asking if anybody was injured and he told him that Ms. Yuille was. Mr. Ferrell said a female also arrived who stated she was a nurse. He said he backed off while they tried to provide medical care to Ms. Yuille.



Mr. Ferrell said he and Ms. Ferrell went into the Eddie Bauer store where they hid in the back of the store with about 15 other people until they were let out by officers. Mr. Ferrell said he did not see the shooter.

**ACTION RECOMMENDED:**

**Narrative:**

On 12/12/2012 at about 0900 hours, I attended the autopsy of Cindy Yuille at the Oregon State Medical Examiner's Office. Dr. Christopher Young was the attending pathologist. Also in attendance were Deputy M.E. Eric Tonsfeldt, Detective Shipley, Canby Evidence Technician Don Hemstreet and Dr. Nici Vance.

Dr. Vance digitally photographed the autopsy as Evidence Technician Hemstreet and I collected clothing and evidence from the decedent. See *attached Property Report for a complete list of items collected.*

I observed the decedent to have one gunshot wound which entered her back, just below her left shoulder blade, and exited her center chest. See *the State Medical Examiner's report for specific details.*

On 12/12/2012 at about 1000 hours, I attended the autopsy of Jacob Roberts at the Oregon State Medical Examiner's Office. Dr. Karen Gunson was the attending pathologist. Also in attendance were Deputy M.E. Eric Tonsfeldt, Detective Shipley, Canby Evidence Technician Don Hemstreet and Dr. Nici Vance.

Dr. Vance digitally photographed the autopsy as Evidence Technician Hemstreet and I collected clothing and evidence from the decedent. See *attached Property Report for a complete list of items collected.*

I observed the decedent to have a massive head wound to the top of his head. An entrance wound was located under the decedent's right ear. See *the State Medical Examiner's report for specific details.*

I observed the decedent to be dressed in jeans, a black short sleeved t-shirt over a black long sleeved thermal shirt and black and green Nike athletic shoes. The decedent was also wearing a black tactical or load bearing vest which was void of any type of ballistic armor. The decedent had orange colored foam style ear plugs in each ear.

One small black and silver colored flashlight was removed from the vest as well as a 30 round metal AR-15 magazine which was stamped on the bottom with a manufacture name of "ProMag". I observed as Canby Evidence Technician Don Hemstreet removed and counted the ammunition from the magazine. The final count was 31 rounds of "FC 223 REM" stamped ammunition.

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The decedent's ear studs, lip stud and contents of his front right pants pocket consisting of a tube of Chapstick and small change were retained by Deputy M.E. Tonsfeldt.

On 12/12/2012 at about 1100 hours, I attended the autopsy of Steven Forsyth at the Oregon State Medical Examiner's Office. Dr. Christopher Young was the attending pathologist. Also in attendance were Deputy M.E. Eric Tonsfeldt, Detective Shipley, Canby Evidence Technician Don Hemstreet and Dr. Nici Vance.

Dr. Vance digitally photographed the autopsy as Evidence Technician Hemstreet and I collected clothing and evidence from the decedent. See *attached Property Report for a complete list of items collected.*

Dr. Young retrieved the decedent's jewelry and pocket contents and placed them into a bag which I marked with the decedent's name and turned over to Deputy M.E. Supervisor Phelps.

I observed the decedent to have a massive head wound to the top of his head. An entrance wound was located near the front hairline, just left of center. See *the State Medical Examiner's report for specific details.*

All evidentiary items were transported in the back of my van to Clackamas County Property Control where they were locked in a secured room overnight.

On 12/13/2012 at about 0800 hours, I removed three clothing items from the paper evidence bags which were collected during the post mortem examination of Steven Forsyth the previous day. Those items were the decedent's dress shirt (item #1), undershirt (item #2) and pants (item #4). Due to bodily fluid contamination, those items were hung in a secured drying locker overnight.

On 12/13/2012 at 0950 hours, I went to the State Medical Examiner's Office and collected a DVD containing images of all three aforementioned autopsies from Dr. Vance. The DVD was later transported to Clackamas County Property Control and entered into evidence on the attached Property Report.

On the afternoon of 12/14/2012, I checked the aforementioned evidentiary items which I had placed into a drying locker overnight. I




On 12/18/12 at approximately 11:15 I received the Oregon City School District records for former student Jacob Roberts. Roberts began high school in the North Clackamas district but then transferred to Oregon City for his senior year.

The school official told me that because Roberts graduated in June 2008 the school district only retains the former student's transcript and a summary of discipline. There are no other records to obtain.

The transcript shows that Roberts graduated with a 2.12 cumulative grade point average. There were only three discipline entries, none of them serious or violent in nature:

- 10/05/2007 – He left campus with another student who was smoking.
- 02/27/2008 – In the main lobby he pulled the pants of a girl down for an incident involving chewing gum.
- 04/18/2008 – He skipped third period.

## NARRATIVE:

On 12-13-12 Detective Mike Copenhaver asked me to contact Bonnie North to photograph a series of text messages between her and Jacob Roberts that she had saved on her cell phone. Detective Copenhaver told me Bonnie North is an ex-

girlfriend of Mr. Roberts and that he had already interviewed her. I called Ms. North and made arrangements to meet with her. Ms. North told me she had saved all the text messages between her and Mr. Roberts since their relationship began in September 2012 until it ended a few weeks ago. She said there were hundreds of text messages. I asked her if she was able to email the text messages to me and she said she didn't know if that was possible but she would check with her cellular provider and or the company who made her phone to try to find a way to forward messages.


At 1:25 pm Detective Chris Cate and I made contact with Ms. North at her grandmother's home located at 15883 S. Apperson Blvd. in Oregon City. Ms. North told us she had determined there is not any way to forward the messages to me. She said the last time she had text messaged with Mr. Roberts was on 12-2-12. Ms. North brought up the text messages on her phone for us. Her phone is a Windows based Nokia Lumia smartphone. Detective Cate photographed each screen starting with 12-2-12 as I scrolled through each screen between photographs. After taking several hundred photographs we decided to end the photographs with the text messages dated 11-15-12.

I read through the majority of messages as Detective Cate was photographing them. Most of them were about making arrangements for Ms. North to come to Mr. Roberts' home, his job and everyday activities for each of them. There was no information that would be crucial to this investigation. Ms. North told me she would continue to save the messages on her phone.

Later, Detective Cate transferred the photos of the text messages to a CD and I submitted the CD to the property room.

## NARRATIVE:

On 12-14-12 at about 11:00 am I received the attached CAD printout regarding this investigation dated 12-13-12 at 2021 hours. The CAD indicates Sharon Gaffney called to report her daughter, Jamie Gibson, was in the food court at Clackamas Town Center at the time of the shooting. It also states that her daughter was a witness and was shot at by the suspect. Ms. Gaffney is concerned because her

daughter refuses to talk about the incident and states she has not been interviewed by law enforcement.

At 11:15 am I left a voice mail message for Ms. Gaffney. At 1:00 pm I received a call back from Ms. Gaffney. She told me she got a call on 12-11-12 at about 3:30 pm from her 17-year-old daughter, Jamie Gibson, who told her there had been a shooting at the mall. She said Jamie told her she would be hearing a lot of sirens and not to worry because she was okay. Ms. Gaffney said Jamie kind of laughed and she does that when she is under stress.

Ms. Gaffney said Jamie attends Clackamas Middle College near the mall and she thought that was where Jamie was calling from. She said she looked online and saw the reports about the shooting at the mall and how serious it was so she called Jamie back and asked her where she was at. Jamie said she was in the mall when the shooting happened but she was able to get outside. She said Jamie was with three of her school friends and had gone to the mall with her friends to wait to be picked up at 5:30 pm. Ms. Gaffney told Jamie to go back to Clackamas Middle College and she would pick her up there.


After Ms. Gaffney picked up Jamie someone gave them a phone number to call while she was driving and said the police were asking witnesses to call the number. She said she called the number and spoke to a woman and told her that Jamie had seen the shooter and knew what he was wearing. Ms. Gaffney said they wanted to help the police find the shooter and the woman asked to talk to Jamie so she handed Jamie the phone. She said she assumed it was someone connected to the police they were talking to. It wasn't until later that she determined it was someone from the news media and that they had aired Jamie talking live on the news. Ms. Gaffney was upset that they had mentioned her daughter's name on the news.

I told Ms. Gaffney that I would like to meet with Jamie to get her account of what she witnessed. Ms. Gaffney told me at this point she didn't feel Jamie had anything to offer that we didn't already know and felt it might be more harmful for Jamie to have to relay the incident to us. She said Jamie can't stop thinking about it and refuses to answer the questions she has about what she actually saw. Jamie did say she was at the top of the escalator in the food court when the shooting started. Jamie told Ms. Gaffney that she didn't see anyone get shot and Jamie never told Ms. Gaffney that the man was shooting at her.

Ms. Gaffney said what she really want is for Jamie to talk to a counselor because she knows this had an adverse effect on her. She said she would ask Jamie if she wanted to talk to me and let me know if she does.

## NARRATIVE:

On 12-17-12 at 10:45 am I made telephone contact with Stephen Pederson regarding a call he made to our tip line on 12-14-12 at 5:36 pm. The tip report stated that Mr. Pederson was a friend of Jacob Roberts and was supposed to meet with Mr. Roberts at the mall on Tuesday but got "stood up".

Mr. Pederson told me that Mr. Roberts was a "nice kid" and he was feeling really bad about what Mr. Roberts did. He said he never saw any indication that Mr. Roberts would do anything like this.

Mr. Pederson told me he met Jake Roberts when he was working at the Mt. Tabor Theater on 48<sup>th</sup> and Hawthorne in Portland in 2010. Mr. Pederson said he worked there for about a year and quit in June 2011. He said the theater is a club and bar. He said Mr. Roberts was working next door at Big Bertha's and he became friends with Mr. Roberts and another Jake who worked at Big Bertha's. Mr. Pederson said he saw Mr. Roberts quite frequently while they were both working. He said he would hang out at Big Bertha's during his work breaks and Mr. Roberts would give him free sandwiches sometimes. He described Mr. Roberts as a really nice person. Mr. Pederson said he never showed any signs of distress, was always in a good mood and always had a smile on his face. He said he had never seen any signs of violence or depression in Mr. Roberts. He said he didn't associate with Mr. Roberts outside of work and did not have much contact with him after he quit working at the theater.

Mr. Pederson said he stopped in at Big Bertha's sometime during the spring of 2012 to say hello to Mr. Roberts. He said he ran into Mr. Roberts in June or July 2012 at the Arby's on SE 82<sup>nd</sup> and King Road. He said Mr. Roberts was with a friend who he had never seen before. Mr. Pederson described the friend with Mr. Roberts as a white male in his 20's with a shaved head. He told me they were skateboarding and said they had come from Mr. Roberts nearby apartment. Mr. Pederson said Mr. Roberts and his friend "looked like they had been doing drugs". He said he knew from previous conversations with Mr. Roberts that he did have a problem with drinking too much and Mr. Roberts told him stories about using cocaine in the past.

Mr. Pederson told me that he would randomly run into Mr. Roberts once in a while. He said he saw Mr. Roberts at the mall once and saw him on a bus. He said he had not seen Mr. Roberts for many months until about two weeks ago when he ran into him in the Clackamas area. He said they talked about hanging out and Mr. Roberts gave him his phone number on a piece of paper which he no longer has.

Mr. Pederson said he saw Mr. Roberts on the Thursday or Friday before the shooting happened near the bus stop at 82<sup>nd</sup> and King Road. He said he and Mr. Roberts talked for a minute and he told Mr. Roberts they should hang out over the weekend. He said Mr. Roberts told him to give him a call. During the conversation, Mr. Pederson mentioned to Mr. Roberts that he might be at the Clackamas Town Center over the weekend and Mr. Roberts told him he lived close to the mall. He said Mr. Roberts seemed like he was in a good mood but now that he thinks about it he thought Mr. Roberts looked kind of "drained". He said he assumed Mr. Roberts looked that way because he was tired from working. He said Mr. Roberts had a skateboard and he saw him go in and out of the liquor store while he was waiting for the bus.


Mr. Pederson told me he went to the Clackamas Town Center at about 2:00 pm on Tuesday (12-11-12). He said he took the bus there and was planning on buying movie tickets for "The Hobbit" but he never ended up buying the tickets. He said he called Mr. Roberts' cell phone while he was at the mall but his phone went directly to voicemail. He said he didn't leave a message. Mr. Pederson said he didn't have any confirmed plans for any particular date to meet Mr. Roberts at the mall and he was not "stood up" by Mr. Roberts on 12-11-12 as the tip sheet indicated. He said he was



only in the mall for about 45 minutes and left on the bus around 3:00 pm. He did not find out about the shooting at the mall until sometime later and he didn't realize it was Mr. Roberts from the initial photo that was shown on the media. It wasn't until later when they were showing a more recent photo of him on the news.

Bonnie and Anthony both agreed to be interviewed by detectives and I escorted them up to the 3 rd floor interview rooms. Veronica and Joshua both said they had no information about this crime or the suspect and they waited in the lobby.

I introduced Bonnie and Anthony to Detective Copenhaver and Victim's Advocate Caroline Holmes. Interviews commenced.


